#### Extension Lecture on Gender Discrimination and violence against Women is a Human Rights Issue not a Women's Issue

#### Dated 23.09.2016 at Room No-207, Dept. of Social Work, Maulana Azad National Urdu University

An extension lecture on "Gender Discrimination and violence against Women is a Human Rights Issue not a Women's Issue" was organized by the Department of Social Work, MANUU on dated 23.09.2016 to aware and sensitize young minds about gender, myths related to masculinity and process of genderization.

Dr. Farzana, Programme Manager, was the resource persons and experts on Gender and Human Rights from My Choices, a reputed non-governmental organization working in Hyderabad. It was stressed that India is the most unsafe place for girls to take birth keeping in view the gravity of crime against women as one rape takes place in every 20 minutes and one out of five is a child.

She started the session with an interesting individual exercise that helped the participants to reflect back on the process of socialization and our orientation towards the understanding of the gender issues leading to unfold how over a period of time we assign certain identity markers to define the difference between male and female on the basis of customs governed by the patriarchal and masculine forces and mindset.

She further talked about the reasons and highlighted that the society always see male and female in binary and versus leading to rule over women which is an unfortunate and deep rooted problem of every society in different forms.



She also put light upon common saying in our culture i.e. 'Itna to chalta hai' (This much is ok and acceptable) or 'auraton ka parde me rahna hamare culture ka hissa hai' (Keeping Women in Purdah is part of our culture) on the basis of which people restrict women's freedom and legitimize it irrespective of thinking about the dignity and self esteem of female counterpart.



Further, Dr. Md Shahid Raza, Head, Department of Social Work discussed this oppression against women and children from the human rights perspective. He stressed on the need to sensitize ourselves and people around us ranging from our family to community and to the larger masses. He also encouraged participants to relook and reexamine our socialization process and see at what times we are taught to be superior/dominant over female counterpart.

All the research scholars and students actively took part in the discussion and raised several questions related to gender issues, women's right and notions of masculinity.

Mr. Md Israr Alam, In charge Guest Lecture emphasized the need and importance of discussion and awareness on such social problems specially for students who are the future leaders and torch bearers of progressive and just society. Around 50 students and teaching and non teaching staff from different departments took part in this talk. Talk was very interactive as participants raised different questions and issues for clarification on various related issues.

Dr. Aftab Alam, Assistant Professor, Dr. Rafat Aara and Dr. Tarique Najamee, Guest Faculty were also present during the programme and motivated the students.

An extension lecture on "<u>Public Health as concerns of Social Work</u>" was organized by the Department of Social Work, MANUU on dated 03.02.2017 to know, understand and reflect upon the roles of Social Work Profession towards the issues related to Public Health and how it is an important concern of Social Work Practice.

Mr. Md Israr Alam, Faculty in-charge, Guest Lecture welcomed and introduced the guest and put light on the need to have discussion on issues of Public Health as concern for social workers.

Prof. Zubair Meenai, Department of Social Work, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi was the resource person and expert on the theme. He started his address with emphasis on motivation and commitment of social worker as an integral attribute to deliver effective services to community and society. After that he facilitated brainstorming among participants on major common diseases associated with human life in general and children in particular. It was revealed that prevalence of certain diseases is associated with certain socio economic categories characterized lack of resources. 'Resources of various natures are important for quality of life but unfortunately there is huge inequality as far as the distribution and ownership of resources are concerned' said the resource person. He further added that this unfortunate condition is more a manmade phenomena than a natural system.

"The principle of social justice and human rights are central to social work" said Prof. Zubair Meenai and thus the concern for public health appears to be very important domain of social work practice especially with regard to socio-economically backward and marginalized section of society.

He emphasized the strength of social work profession in terms of training and skill set which can be proved quite effective to address the issues related to public health in terms of problem identification, community mobilization, community organization and resource mobilization.

Further, Dr. Md Shahid Raza, Head, Department of Social Work pointed out that social workers need to redefine their role of empowerment and development of people with dignity and inclusion. He opined that students of social work has good opportunity to develop understanding of issues related to public health at grass root level through is concurrent field work.

Dr. Aftab Alam, Assistant Professor, Mr. Abu Osama, Assistant Professor, and Dr. Rafat Aara, Guest Faculty were also present during the programme and motivated the students.
