The council noted, agreed fully and consented to the items placed from among the minutes of 1 to 7 meetings of the Executive Council, which are as follows:

	the Council was of the view that the introduction of these courses be deferred for the time being.
Third Meeting held on 27 th January, 2000	<p>i. The Eligibility Test Admissions to 1st year B.A., & B.Com. was held on 19/09/99 at 35 places in the country besides Hali (KSA) and Muscat (Oman). 3,489 candidates appeared of whom 3,316 qualified for admission.</p> <p>ii. On the closing date for admissions, a total of 3,639 candidates (E.T. qualified as well as those with 10 + 2 or equivalent) completed the admission formalities for 1st year B.A. / B.Com. and 124 candidates sought admission to the Certificate in Food and Nutrition programme.</p> <p>iii. It would be necessary to establish new study centres following the guidelines already formulated by the University entering into MOU's with the respective Heads of Institutions / Managements to meet the requirements of newly admitted students and appoint part-time coordinators and other supporting staff.</p> <p>iv. The council ratified appointments of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Examiners for paper setting and rates of remuneration / fee paid to them ▪ Prescribing registration fee of Rs. 600/- for the eligibility test ▪ Authorizes Vice – Chancellor to establish new Study Centres as per need following guidelines prescribed pending framing of necessary ordinance in this regard. <p>v. The first University exam was conducted in Nov. '99 for 1994 students of 1st year B.A. (1998 – 99 batch) at all the Study Centres. The council ratifies examination fee, remuneration prescribed for examination staff, the panel of examiners and fee and remuneration paid to them.</p>

	<i>(Note: Observers from the University were deputed. The results thereof were notified in Jan. 2000. It was opined that the names of the examiners be kept secret as far as possible and examiners from other places be considered)</i>
Fourth Meeting held on 24 th July, 2000	<p>1) Receipt of grant of Rs. 50.0 lakhs from IGNOU for Development of Distance Education Programme by the Distance Education Council</p> <p><i>(Note: The Council appreciated the generous grant of Rs. 50.00 lakhs by Distance Education Council, IGNOU, for development of Distance Education Programme of MANUU).</i></p> <p>2) The Council approved establishment of Study Centre in Riyadh (KSA) and also suggested that similar study centers be established in Qatar and other places in the Gulf where Indian population is resident.</p> <p>3) The Council agreed to views of the Vice Chancellor that the University should initially cater to the needs of the lower, middle and weaker sections of society and courses should be oriented to help these sections.</p> <p>4) The Council was of the view that there is an immediate need to open more Study Centres in UP and other such areas.</p>
Fifth Meeting held on 3 rd March, 2001	<p>1) To consider and approve Programmes of Study to be offered during the academic year 2001 – 2002 by distance and conventional mode <i>(The EC approved establishment of following departments on campus and introduction of courses as under;</i></p> <p><i>Department of Urdu</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Diploma in Script writing (one year)</i> ▪ <i>Diploma in Urdu Computing (one year)</i> <p><i>Department of English</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Certificate Programme in Functional English for Urdu Speakers (six months)</i> ▪ <i>Diploma in teaching of English for the teachers of English in Urdu medium schools (one year)</i>

- *Diploma in Education Training Programme for primary and upper primary Urdu medium school teachers (two years)*

- *M.A. in history with special emphasis on those aspects of History which are included in all competitive examinations of the country with one full paper on current affairs*

<p>Seventh Meeting held on 27th October 2001</p>	<p>1) To report launching of D.Ed. course by MANUU <i>(Note: The University has launched Diploma in Education, one year course through conventional mode of education in 2001).</i></p> <p>2) Consider non-response for Certificate in Computing Course <i>(Note: The University had launched CIC but received no applications. It was decided to reduce the fees from 1500/- rupees to 1000/- rupees to attract students).</i></p>
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Item 15: Recognition and granting of equivalency certificate to degrees / certificates of various Institutions

The Council approved the recognition of Urdu Fazil of Idarae Adabiyati Urdu for admission of D. Ed. Course of this University as equivalent to the Board of Secondary Education, A.P. for admission into B. A., B. Com courses.

The Council also approved the recognition of the 12th class pass certificate of All India Board of Sec. Education, Delhi for admission to graduation courses of this University. The Council approved the Fazilat/Alimat degrees of Al-Jamiatul Asaria Darul Hadees as equivalent to 10+2 for admission to degree courses for this University.

Item 16: Recognition of examinations of one University by another on reciprocal basis and also recognition of Degrees awarded by Open Universities

The A. C. resolved to entrust the matter to the Committee of Equivalence to be constituted by the University.
