

The Vice-Chancellor initiated the proceedings by welcoming the Members and thanking them for attending meeting.

Before taking up the agenda, he presented a brief status of the academic activities of the University and also informed the Members about the revival of the posts of IX Plan by the UGC. He also informed that till now the University concentrated only on the Distance Education Programmes, but now given the sanction of the posts by UGC, the University proposes to launch on Campus Master's Level Programmes. This is also done because, concurrent with the release of the posts by the UGC, it has also stipulated that the University offered these courses which include M.A. (Urdu), M. A. (Hindi), M. A. (English), M. A. (Communication & Journalism) & Masters in Business Administration.

Shri Shahid Mehdi and Prof. Ramamurthy commended the Vice Chancellor on the work taken up by him and put on record their appreciation for reviving the teaching positions from the UGC.

Prof. Mohd. Iqbal and Prof. Ramamurthy appreciated the services rendered by the Former Vice-Chancellor, Prof. M. S. Jairajpuri to the University. The same is placed on record.

The Minutes of the Meeting of the Academic Council held on 20th June 2002 were confirmed.

The matter was discussed at length and the Academic Council ratified the introduction of the One-year Diploma Course (Teach English) for this academic year.

However, the Academic Council opined that the "Objectives of the Course", as they exist now, should be suitably amended to read as " to enable the teachers of English in urdu medium schools to better their English" instead of "to enable them to become better teachers of English". Prof Vasant Gadre was of the opinion that since this is a course to teach English, counseling sessions are indispensable and the same should be arranged. This change too should be incorporated under the "Counseling and Support Services" section.

The Course should be offered in the next academic year (2005) with these changes.

Item 4

Post-facto ratification for launch of Six - months Certificate course in Functional English for Urdu speakers.

The matter was discussed at length and ratified the same with following incorporations in the admission criteria of the above course, which is as under:

Suggestion from Prof. V. Gadre for incorporation:

Instead of using the words "whose mother tongue is Urdu" it is proposed that the following may used: "who are Proficient in Urdu".

The suggestion was approved by the Academic Council.

Point 1(5) and Point 6.0.0, 6.1.1 & 6.1.2 relating the Professor of Eminence may be deleted.

Apart from the above, the following line from point 2 of 1.1. may be deleted:

"In exceptional cases, the Teachers with 15 years of UG Teaching/Research experience also be considered".

The Draft Statute is approved with the above changes.
