Subject: Approval of additional faculty positions in School of Education/Faculty of Education in Central Universities- reg.

Sir,

This is in reference to your office letter No.MANUU/E.R-1(B)/F.134/2015-16/89 dated 18th April, 2018 and presentation made by the university before the Committee constituted for this purpose on 12.07.2019. The proposal of the university was considered by the Committee. The recommendations of the Committee were placed before the Commission in its 544th meeting held on 16th October, 2019. The Commission considered and approved the recommendations of the Committee. Accordingly, the approval of UGC is hereby conveyed for creation of 33 (Thirty three) teaching positions at the level of Assistant Professor for MANUU constituent Teacher Education Colleges at Srinagar, Bhopal, Darbhanga, Asansol and Aurangabad. The details of faculty positions are as given below.

Sr. No.	Name of the College of Teacher Education of MANUU	No. of posts recommended at the level of Assistant Professor
1.	College of Teacher Education, Srinagar (J&K)	3 (Three)
2.	College of Teacher Education, Bhopal (MP)	10 (Ten)
3.	College of Teacher Education, Darbhanga (Bihar)	12 (Twelve)
4.	College of Teacher Education, Asansol	6 (Six)
5.	College of Teacher Education, Aurangabad (MS)	2 (Two)
	Total	33 (Thirty Three)

Further, post-facto approval of the UGC is conveyed for establishment of Colleges of Teacher Education (CTEs) at Sambhal (U.P.), Asansol (W.B.) and Aurangabad (M.S.) w.e.f. the academic session 2014-15 as NCTE has already granted its approval for starting B.Ed. courses at these Colleges.

The University may also consider reallocating the positions from the Headquarters at Hyderabad as the number of faculty is in excess than the requirement.


It has also been observed by the Commission that the number of seats are filled up much less than allocated seats. Therefore, the Faculty may be taken by the teacher student ratio. If there is any shortage according to teacher work load, University may engage the guest faculty.

The expenditure on teaching positions approved for School of Education/Faculty of Education may be incurred out of the funds provided under salary head (36) of Annual allocation of 2019-20.

The above approval is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-


- (i) The University may strictly adhere the reservation policy for SC/ST/OBCs/EWS/PwD as per Govt. of India policy while filling up the teaching positions.
- (ii) The University may fill up the sanctioned teaching posts in a phased manner as per actual requirement under intimation to UGC.
- (iii) The UGC Regulations 2018 as amended from time to time related to Minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in Higher Education should be strictly followed.
