Item No. 6.11: Amendment to Clause 6 of evaluation regulation of University.

The Academic council considered the amendment to clause 6 of evaluation regulations of the University and approved the amendment clause which reads as follows:

"Students are permitted to move to II Semester irrespective of their results in 1<sup>st</sup> Semester However, no student shall be permitted to move to 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester if he/she has more then 25% theory paper as backlog cumulatively of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester"

Item No. 6.12: Relaxation of existing minimum qualifying marks from 50% to 45% for admission to Post Graduate regular courses.

The Academic Council considered the matter of relaxation of existing minimum qualifying marks from 50% to 45% for admission to Post Graduate on campus courses and resolved to maintain status quo with a provision to give relaxation to SC/ST up to 10% for time being subject to periodical review.

Item No 6.13. Introduction of PG course in M.A. (Translation) from academic year 2006-07 at Hyderabad.

The Academic Council had a detailed discussion regarding introduction of PG courses in M.A. (Translation) from the academic year 2006-07. Prof. Abdul Sattar Dalvi, Mr. Nayeem Akhtar, Dr. Ali Raza Moosvi, Prof. Rekha Pande, Prof. K.R. Iqbal Ahmed, Dr. Imtiyaz Ahmed, Dr. Abbas Khan A.A. participated in discussion and made certain suggestions in respect of structure and the contents of the course to be introduced. After threadbare discussion it was resolved that M.A. (Translation) be launched from academic year 2006-07 subject to condition;

- (a) The Head of the Departments shall place a detailed structure of the course and detailed syllabus by incorporating all the suggestions made by the members before the BoS for its consideration;
- (b) After the approval of the above by BoS the matter may be placed before the Academic Council before the commencement of course from the academic year 2006-07.

Item No. 6.14: Proposal for fixing of honorarium for full / half day basis during practicals & Practical examinations etc including conveyance allowances.

The Academic Council accepted the proposal for fixing the honorarium as proposed by Department of Mass Communication & Journalism.

Item No. 6.15: Admission procedure for the M.A. (Mass Communication & Journalism)

The Academic Council approved the procedure of admission for M.A. (MCJ). During the discussion, Mr. Nayeem Akhtar suggested that during interview emphasis be laid on personality assessment. The Head of Department of MCJ was advised to consider this aspect during interview process.

Item No. 6.16: Reservation of 25% seats for women candidates in M.A. regular programmes.

The Academic Council considered reservation up to 25% seats for women candidates for M.A. in MCJ and resolved that up to 25% of the seats be allotted to women candidates on preferential basis.

It was also agreed by the Academic Council that this regulation shall not apply to Distance Education Department. The Directorate of Distance Education was asked to prepare separate regulation for Distance Education candidates.
