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



Item No.7.19

Sub: Syllabus and scheme of Examination for M.A. in Public Administration.

An Adhoc Board of Studies for the Department of Political Science & Public Administration was constituted to prepare syllabus, scheme of examinations and admission regulations. The course is divided into 2 semesters with 2 papers in each semester. Sub: Introduction of Diploma in Arabic Translation

The adhoc Board of Studies in Arabic under the Chairmanship of Prof. Khalid Saeed, Dean-School of Languages, Linguistics & Indology met on Saturday, the 3rd of June 2006 in the University and recommended Introduction of One year Diploma in Arabic Translation which consists of 3 units – Introduction to Translation, Translation from Arabic to Urdu and vice-versa and Translation from English to Arabic and vice-versa. The adhoc Board felt that the programme – Diploma in Translation, may be included in the teaching programme of the University as there is a great demand for translation for Arabic to Urdu and English and vice-versa in different fields of education and administration in India and abroad. This programme is designed to fulfill the need of translation. The details of the course like duration of the programme, structure of the programme, eligibility, fee, etc. is enclosed at **Annexure- XII**.

Sub: Introduction of Optional Arabic at graduation level (through distance mode)

The adhoc Board of Studies in Arabic under the Chairmanship of Prof. Khalid Saeed, Dean-School of Languages, Linguistics & Indology met on Saturday, the 3rd of June 2006 in the University and recommended to start the Optional paper of Arabic at under graduation level through distance mode. The Board felt that the Introduction of Optional Arabic would help large number of Urdu students of this University for seeking jobs in Gulf countries and also in schools where Arabic is taught as one of the subjects, placed at **Annexure-XIII**
