### Minutes of the 2nd Board of Studies (BoS) meeting held on 11th & 12th December 2015.

The Board of Studies meeting of the Department of Sociology was held on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of December 2015, as scheduled. The following members attended the meeting and contributed to the deliberations regarding developing and approving the syllabus for the fifth and sixth Semesters of B.A., course and for the existing pattern of non-CBCS third and fourth Semester courses of M.A programme; reviewing and approving of the Syllabus prepared previously for certain semesters for the B.A and M.A., courses. Further the BoS has discussed and approved to introduce the CBCS in the department of Sociology along the pattern adapted by the School of Arts and Social Sciences/university, w.e.f. the academic year of 2016-17;

#### The Board discussed the agenda and the following decisions were made.

- 1. The syllabus of the courses for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester M.A. in Sociology as per the present pattern (For the on going batch as per the pre-CBCS pattern) was discussed and approved. The courses thus decided and the syllabus correspondingly finalized and approved, etc., are given in the **annexure 1**:
- 2. Further, the Board of Studies has also discussed the modalities for Dissertation work in the final semester of the Masters' programme and finalized that the students would undertake fieldwork for a minimum of two weeks. It is decided that the selection of the topic and supervisor and other modalities pertaining to this paper, fieldwork/dissertation will be finalised in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester itself. In this regard it is decided that the Dissertation shall carry 100 marks/4 credits, out of which 70 marks will be based on evaluation of the written Report (Dissertation) and 30 marks for the Viva-Voce examination.
- 3. It was also decided that the Field trip will be undertaken during the winter vacation, immediately after the closing of the third semester. The Committee felt that one faculty member may also accompany the students, if needed, during their fieldwork. It was also decided that the students shall pay travel expenses for their field trips. A general university norm will be applied to seek University's contribution to add to the students' contributions.
- 4. It is also decided to work out an estimate of the students' fieldwork fee and notify it in the Prospectus itself. The fee may be charged as part of the M.A. 4<sup>th</sup> Semester fees.
- 5. The BoS has also discussed and approved the syllabus of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semester Courses for B.A., in Sociology. The courses that were discussed and approved are given in the annexure II, along with the syllabus:

#### Introduction/Adapting the CBCS Pattern:

6. The Head, Department of Sociology in the capacity of the Chairperson of the Board of Studies, has briefed the members about the modalities adopted by the School of Arts and Social Sciences regarding the implementation/adapting of Choice Based Credit System



(CBCS). Referring to the minutes of the HoDs level meeting of the SA&SS, he explained that as per the decisions taken in this regard, the existing CBCS system introduced in the university, pertaining to the UG (BA) level courses will be continued.

- 7. In addition to this, the BoS has discussed and approved the CBCS based pattern for the P.G (M.A) level courses. Accordingly the courses and syllabus of the M.A. courses of the Department of Sociology are evolved in line with the pattern adapted by the School of Arts and Social Sciences.
- 8. However, the members pointed out that it is best to keep the number of courses and credits at the minimum desirable level that was allowed by the UGC so as to avoid load for the students as well as teachers. While in principle the Board approved the current formula approved by the School, it wanted to suggest this point to the School for its further deliberations.
- 9. The Board has also agreed to keep a maximum number of students per each CBCS (Elective) course at the Masters' level. It is decided to have a maximum of 20 students of other disciplines per each CBCS Course offered by the Department. There is however no minimum number of students. The admission of students into the CBCS courses in the Department will be purely on the basis of merit. For the first semester, the basis is decided to be the students' performance in the Qualifying examination and for the second, third and fourth semester CBCS courses, it is decided that the student's performance in the previous semester as the yardstick for selection.
- 10. Following this, the list of courses to be taken up for teaching in different academic sessions/semesters at M.A., level, (following the CBCS pattern that is to be started w.e.f. the academic year 2016-17) and the syllabus for each course are finalized and approved. The list of such papers and syllabus are given in the annexure III.
- 11. Finally the Board of Studies meeting has ended with the formal vote of thanks offered by Dr. Shazia Farooq Fazli, Assistant Professor of the Department of Sociology.
