**Special Examinations (for Regular Mode Final Year Students only)**

**Sub: MANUU – Examination Branch (Regular Mode) - Conduct of Special Exams for Final Semester Students - Notification - Issued.**


**Ref: Approval of the 48th Meeting of the Academic Council Item No. 48.4.04 (i).**

It is hereby notified that the Special Examinations for the students of final year shall be conducted for all Diploma/ UG/ PG Programmes in July 2026. Only as an exception, the students who fail in the final even semester and immediately preceding odd semester (i.e., last odd and last even semesters of a programme) shall get a chance to register for the backlog papers in the Special Exam.

The eligibility of students to appear for Special Exams shall be as follows:

- i. Students who have failed / obtained less than 5 CGPA in the final Odd / Even Semester exams shall be permitted to complete the program.
- ii. Students shall be permitted to appear in 50% of the courses.
- iii. The special exams shall be only for theory exams and practical exams. This shall not be applicable for Continuous Internal Assessment / Projects/ Teaching Practices / Field Visit, etc.
- iv. Special exams shall be only for the current batch of final year students only provided there are no backlog courses in other preceding semesters.
- v. This shall not apply for improvement examinations.
- vi. This shall not be applicable to PhD course work exams and other add-on programs.
- vii. Students detained due to shortage of attendance shall not be permitted.
- viii. Students appearing in special exams shall not be eligible for gold medals / University rank certificates etc.
- ix. Exam fee for each theory / practical course shall be Rs.100/- per course for the Special exam.
- x. The last date for submission of Backlog Exam Fee is 29.6.2026.
- xi. The Backlog Examination shall be held immediately after the re-opening of the University. The Exam Time Table shall be available on the University website.
- xii. Students can download the Hall Tickets one day before the commencement of the Special Examinations.

Any student desiring to exit the Program under NEP, shall also be permitted to appear for the Special Examinations.
