The Directorate of Distance Education, MANUU, has a Grievance Redress System. DDE has a well-established Student Support Services Unit that addresses students' grievances through mail, social media and telephonic conversations. The details of unit are given on university website for the information of students. The University also provides an online facility for submitting grievances and tracking their status. The University follows the guidelines and standards laid down in the Annexure X of the Regulations. The University ensures that the officers deputed for learner support are able to provide guidance to learners on submitting grievances. The University also ensures that the grievances are addressed in a timely manner.

Every Regional Centre and LSC takes proactive steps to prevent the turning of an enquiry into a complaint and a grievance. If not addressed promptly and appropriately a simple issue can easily change from a normal case to a grievance. Grievances could be a result of many things, unavailability of learner support services, excessive delays, impolite staff behavior, discrimination or malpractices. The effectiveness of grievance redressal can be assessed based on the count and nature of cases received, time taken for corrective action and the repetitive nature of grievances.

The DDE has an effective grievance redressal mechanism with dedicated help desks at all its RCs, Sub-RCs and LSCs and a dedicated centre namely the Student Support Service Unit (SSSU), established at DDE, MANUU headquarters looking into learner grievances. The SSU and all the other help desks will provide the right information at the right time, redress grievances at every stage, and provide counselling from time to time and bridge the gap between the University and the student.

The grievances are normally received through a letter, e-mail, and telephone. The web portal is also being used to redress the incoming grievances. The mechanism is centralized linking all RCs, Sub-RCs and LSCs with the SSSU at the Headquarters.
