Item No. 21.1: To discuss and consider the feasibility of Re-starting the Admissions to various courses offered at Polytechnics, Dharbanga, and Bangalore – Reg.

The Academic Council was briefed about the circumstances under which the Admission notification was withheld for Admissions to the MANUU Polytechnics at Darbhanga and Bangalore during Academic Year 2013-2014.

The members were informed about the efforts made to meet the requirements of AICTE. However, initially there were problems of provision of building and basic infrastructure due to hurdles in the purchase procedures. Now the requirement of Land is fulfilled and the basic infrastructure can be provided as per the latest Purchase Manual prepared by the University.

Further, it was informed that the validity of certificates issued to the successful students of these Polytechnics have been generally accepted in all offices of the Central and State Governments for **Higher Education and Employment**. However, it was also informed that some States insist upon the AICTE recognition. The Principal, Polytechnic, Hyderabad informed that some of the successful students are employed and some of them are pursuing higher education also.

As regards restarting of admissions, it was informed that various representations were received from Bengaluru and Darbhanga. Accordingly, the Coordinator of Polytechnic Colleges/Principal, Polytechnic, Hyderabad processed the requests from these quarters to restart admissions in MANUU Polytechnics at Bengaluru and Darbhanga during this Academic Year 2013-2014.

Therefore, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor constituted a Committee to review the matter and to "make assessment of the situation of Polytechnics at Bengaluru and Darbhanga to continue the courses". The Committee made recommendations about admissions to Polytechnics at Bengaluru and Darbhanga for this Academic Year 2013-2014.

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor observed that it is important: -

- ✓ To safeguard the resultant reflection "on future of student community" at Bengaluru and Darbhanga and
- ✓ To accomplish one of the fundamental aspect of University Act vis-à-vis Objectives of the University i.e., "to impart education and training in vocational and technical subjects through the medium of Urdu"

The Pro-Vice Chancellor, who is the Chairman of the Committee, then presented the recommendations of the Committee. The Pro-Vice Chancellor informed the august body that the Committee considered all aspects in detail and recommended to restart the Admissions at Polytechnics, Bengaluru and Darbhanga in view of the following developments: -

- *Fulfillment of land requirements: MANUU has 1.9 acre of land in Bengaluru and 4.00 acre (approx.) contiguous land in Darbhanga;*
- *Semi-permanent structures may be constructed in these areas to meet the requirement of accommodation as per AICTE norms;*
- *The Polytechnics may continue to operate from these semi-permanent structures till regular construction is ready;*
- *The space required at Bengaluru Campus can be created by suitable modifications in the present MANUU premises available;*
- *The current intake of 40 students per program shall be continued;*
- *Provision of furniture and necessary lab equipments for Polytechnics, Bengaluru and Darbhanga will be provided by the University; and*
- *Undertaking from students be taken at the time of admission regarding the intimation of AICTE status;*


Thereafter, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor requested the Members to offer their Comments on recommendation of the Committee regarding the restart of "admissions in Polytechnics at Bengaluru and Darbhanga.


Prof. Kancha Ilaiyah, *Director, CSSEIP* expressed that the completion of formalities of requirements of AICTE are subjective assessment. He opined that the University should go ahead with the admissions for this Academic Year 2013-2014.

Prof. K. R. Iqbal Ahmed, *Director, DDE/Dean, School of Management and Commerce* appreciated the Vice Chancellor for his deliberate efforts in constitution of Committee to review the Admissions for Polytechnic Colleges and Bengaluru and Darbhanga and appreciated the recommendations of the Committee.

The Academic Council finally **unanimously** resolved to approve the recommendations of the Committee to restart the process of issue of Admission Notification at MANUU Polytechnics at Bengaluru and Darbhanga. Further, the house advised that efforts should be made to fulfill the AICTE requirements before applying for recognition of Polytechnic Courses.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
