**RECOGNITION ORDER**

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Gachibowli, Hyderabad, Pin code-500032, Andhra Pradesh** has submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for conducting **B.Ed. (Urdu Innovative) Course** with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred Only)** students on **30.10.2014** in the name of **College of Teacher Education, Nuh, Distt.- Mewat, Haryana**.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institution against letter of intent, the Northern Regional Committee in its **238<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the NRC held from 20-31 May, 2015** is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the **B.Ed. (Urdu Innovative)** programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, in light of NCTE headquarter letter No. F-49-15/2013/NCTE/n & S/A-73912 dated 12.09.2013 related to grant of relaxation to the Central Universities under clause 12 of extant NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **College of Teacher Education, Nuh, Distt.- Mewat, Haryana** for conduction **BEd. (Urdu) Innovative Course of Secondary (Level) of Two Years** duration with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty Only)** from the academic session **2015-2016** under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (iv) As per NCTE Headquarter letter No. 49-15/2013/NCTE/N&S/A-73912 dated 12.09.2013, the infrastructural requirement prescribed in the NCTE Norms shall be fulfilled within a period of 3 years provided adequate infrastructural arrangement is made on lease/rented bases as per the stipulation of NCTE.
- (v) The Regional Committees shall keep a watch on the situation and communicate it to the NCTE Hqr. to apprise the Ministry of H.R.D., Govt. of India of the shortcomings so that the same can be fulfilled expeditiously within the period of relaxation. In case at the end of 3 years all the criteria as per the Rules and Regulations of the NCTE are not fulfilled, the Regional Committee would be at liberty to withdraw the recognition given to the respective Central University.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
