

The Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad is a Central University established by an Act of Parliament in 1998 and Member of the Association of Indian Universities.

Your kind attention is invited towards our Circular letter of even number dated 21 May, 1998 through which we had requested all the Member Universities to accord recognition to the Degrees/Diplomas awarded by Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad 500008 (AP).

We have been informed by the University Authorities that the Degrees awarded by them are not accepted by other Universities in the country. Since, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad, is a member of AIU, we once again request to kindly accept their Degrees on reciprocal basis in terms of the following AIU resolution :

"Resolved that the examinations of one university should be recognized by another on a reciprocal basis, provided that the entrance qualifications, duration of course and the general standard of attainment are similar to those prescribed by the recognizing university.

Further resolved that in case of degrees awarded by Open Universities, the conditions regarding entrance qualifications and duration of the course be relaxed provided that the general standard of attainment are similar to those prescribed by the recognizing university."

Subject: Equivalence of Degrees awarded by Open and Distance Learning
 (ODL) Institutions at par with Conventional Universities/ Institutions

Sir/ Madam,

There are a number of Open and Distance Learning Institutions (ODLIs) in the country offering Degree/ Diploma/Certificate programmes through the mode of non formal education. These comprise Open Universities, Distance Education Institutions (either single mode or dual mode) of Central Universities, State Universities, Deemed to be Universities, Institutions of National Importance or any other Institution of Higher learning recognized by Central/State/Statutory Council/Societies registered under the Society Registration Act 1860.

2. A circular was earlier issued vide UGC letter F1 No- 52/2000(CPP-II) dated May 05, 2004 (**copy enclosed**) mentioning that Degrees/Diplomas / Certificates/ awarded by the Open Universities in conformity with the UGC notification of degrees be treated as equivalent to corresponding awards of the traditional Universities in the country.

3. Attention is also invited to UGC circular No F1-25/93(CPP-II) dated 28th July 1993 (**copy enclosed**) for recognition of degrees and diplomas as well as transfer of credit for courses successfully completed by students between the two types of universities so that the mobility of students from Open University stream to traditional universities/ institutions is ensured without any difficulty.



4. The Government of India, in exercise of its power conferred under section 20(1) of UGC Act 1956, issued directions dated 29th December 2012 entrusting UGC with the responsibility of regulating higher education programme in open and distance learning (ODL) mode. Consequently, Universities/ Institutions desirous of offering any programme through distance mode would require recognition of UGC.
5. As you are aware, the Government of India has envisaged a greater role for the Open and the Distance Education System. The envisioned role may be fulfilled by recognizing and treating the Degrees / Diplomas/ Certificates awarded through distance mode at par with the degrees obtained through the formal system of education. Open and Distance Education System in the country is contributing a lot in expansion of Higher Education and for achieving target of GER, without compromising on quality. Non recognition/ non equivalence of degrees of ODL institutions for the purpose of promotion/ employment and pursuing higher education may prove a deterrent to many learners and will ultimately defeat the purpose of Open and Distance Education.
6. Accordingly, the Degrees/ Diplomas/ Certificates awarded for programmes conducted by the ODL institutions, recognized by DEC (erstwhile) and UGC, in conformity with UGC Notification on specification of Degrees should be treated as equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Degree/Diploma/Certificate of the traditional Universities/ institutions in the country.

Subject: Commission Order on the application, submitted Online by the Higher Educational Institution, for recognition of the programmes to be offered in Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode from academic year 2018-19 onwards - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 26 read with clause (j) of Section 12 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017, had been notified in the Gazette of India on 23.06.2017. The first and the second amendment in the principal regulations were notified in the Gazette of India on 11.10.2017 and 06.02.2018 respectively.

2. Part-II; sub-regulations (3) to (5); of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 describes the Recognition process of Higher Educational Institutions for offering Open and Distance Learning programmes. The sub-regulations (3) describes the process of recognition of Higher Educational Institutions offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning Mode, whereas sub-regulations (4) describes the process for withdrawal of recognition and sub-regulations (5) provides right to appeal to Higher Educational Institutions aggrieved with the decision of the Commission.

3. The Commission had invited online applications from the eligible Higher Educational Institutions for offering Open and Distance Learning programmes from the academic session 2018-19 vide public notice F.No. 74-1/2018 (DEB-IV) dated 28.03.2018, mentioning therein that the online portal for submitting applications shall be open from 2nd April, 2018 to 1st May, 2018. It was also mentioned that the duly certified hard copies of the application submitted online mode along with annexures shall reach UGC (DEB) office at 35 Feroze Shah Road, New Delhi-110001 within 10 working days of submission of online application. In response to the public notice dated 28.03.2018, **Maulana Azad National Urdu University** had submitted application online for programme wise recognition by the Commission.

4. Application received from **Maulana Azad National Urdu University** had been scrutinized by the expert committee and deficiency(s) or defect(s) in application were communicated and time period as prescribed in University Grants Commission (Open & Distance



Learning) Regulations, 2017 was given to remove or rectify such deficiency(s) or defect(s) with relevant documentary evidence.

5. **Maulana Azad National Urdu University** was invited for an Interface Meeting with the Expert Committee; constituted by the Chairman of the Commission; on **06, July, 2018** in the UGC office, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi. The Expert Committee based on the application submitted, clarification given for deficiency(s) or defect(s) communicated earlier, the presentation made by the Higher Educational Institution in the Interface Meeting and in terms of provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments; made recommendations for consideration of the Commission.

6. The Commission in its 534th meeting held on 2nd August, 2018 considered the recommendations of the interface expert committee. Based on the decision of the Commission, I am directed to issue this Order, thereby communicating the programme wise recognition status of the programmes to be offered in Open and Distance Learning mode from academic year 2018-19 onwards by the **Maulana Azad National Urdu University** as detailed in point no. 7 below.

For the programmes recognized in 7(A) above, the Higher Educational Institution shall scrupulously abide in letter and spirit by all the terms and conditions, while offering the programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode, as per the provisions detailed in Part-III, Part-IV, Part-V, Part-VI and Annexure-I to Annexure-XI of the University Grants Commission (Open & Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments. Some specific conditions given in UGC(ODL) Regulations, 2017 & its amendments are given in **Annexure 1**.

9. For the programmes found deficient in 7(B) above, the Higher Educational Institution shall submit representation along with documentary evidence, if any, within 30 days from the date of this order as per the provision at clause 4(i) of sub-regulation (3) of Part- II of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments.

10. If the HEI fails to comply with the conditions of recognition or if it is found conducting affairs in a manner that leads to deterioration of academic standards, or if any information, documentary evidence submitted/produced by the HEI is found to be false or fake at a later date, UGC shall take action as per Regulation (4), Part. -II of UGC (ODL) Regulations 2017.

Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to the UGC Orders of even number dated **16.08.2018** and **23.10 2018**, wherein the details of programmes recognized for 2018-19 onwards and programmes not recognized were communicated to **Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Telangana**.

2. As per the provisions under sub-regulation (5) of part-II of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning 2017) Regulations and the decision of the Commission it is 535th meeting held on 27th September, 2018, for the programmes not recognized as per the UGC letter cited in above Para, the Higher Educational Institution had been provided an opportunity to submit an appeal along with requisite fee and documentary evidence, if any within 30 days from the date of the said UGC letter.

3. The appeal along with documents submitted by the **Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Telangana** was placed before duly constituted Standing Appellate Committee in the meeting held on 11th December, 2018, at UGC, 35 Feroze Shah Road, New Delhi. The Standing Appellate Committee based on the appeal submitted along with documentary evidences, interaction with the HEI Authorities and the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments; made recommendations for consideration of the Competent Authority, in accordance to the Commission decision, in its 534th meeting, held on 02.08.2018.

4. Based on the decision of the Competent Authority, I am directed to issue this Order, thereby communicating the decision of the Commission, on the appeal received, for offering **programmes in Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode from academic year 2018-19, session beginning January, 2019 and onwards by the Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Telangana, as detailed in point no. 5 below.**

For the programmes recognized in 5(A) above, the Higher Educational Institution shall scrupulously abide in letter and spirit by all the terms and conditions, while offering the programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode, as per the provisions detailed in Part-III, Part-IV, Part-V, Part-VI and Annexure-I to Annexure-XI of the University Grants Commission (Open & Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments. Some specific conditions given in UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017 & its amendments are given in **Annexure- 1**.

7. If the HEI fails to comply with the conditions of recognition or if it is found conducting affairs in a manner that leads to deterioration of academic standards, or if any information, documentary evidence submitted/produced by the HEI is found to be false or fake at a later date, UGC shall take action as per Regulation (4) Part - II of UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017.

8. Higher Educational Institutions are required to comply with all the provisions of the UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments. If any deviation is noticed, the same would entail not only withdrawal of permission/recognition for such ODL course but also for other courses offered by the institution, on regular and conventional mode, as directed by MHRD vide letter F. No.2-18/2017-U3 (A) dated 07.10.2018 on the recommendations of Justice Reddy Committee constituted by MHRD on the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 03.11.2018 in Civil Appeal No.17869-17870 filed by Orissa Lift Irrigation Corp. Ltd Versus Rabi Sankar Patro & Ors.



9. **Time limit for completion of admission process for offering ODL programmes by HEIs:**

The Commission in its 537th meeting held on 10.12.2018 has decided the time limit for completion of admission process by the HEIs for offering ODL programmes as mentioned below:

- a) Academic session for January - admission last date February end
b) Academic session for July - admission last date August end

The Commission has also directed that the HEIs shall upload the admission details within ten days from the last date of the admissions in the respective academic session i.e. 10th September for July academic session and 10th March for January academic session. Accordingly, the HEIs shall comply with the above decision of Commission.

10. The application stands closed for 2018-19. The HEI needs to apply afresh as and when UGC invites application for recognition of ODL programmes.

11. The decision of the Commission shall be final and binding on the Higher Educational Institutions.

Conditions

1. The total intake capacity (Number of learners) in Open and Distance Learning mode in Higher Educational Institution and/or Learner Support Centre/Study Centre shall be as mentioned in clause 6 of Annexure-X of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its subsequent amendments.
2. The Higher Educational Institution shall offer only those programmes through Open and Distance Learning mode, which are approved by the statutory bodies of the University and by UGC and by the Regulatory Authority, as applicable.
3. The Higher Educational Institution shall not offer any programme in engineering, Medicine, dental, pharmacy, nursing, architecture, physiotherapy and programmes not permitted to be offered in distance mode by any other regulatory body.
4. The Higher Educational Institution shall comply to all the terms and conditions mentioned in the Affidavit dated 20-4-2018, duly notarized and signed by Sh. M.A, Sikandar, Registrar submitted to the Commission vide letter dated 01st May, 2018 and (2) Affidavit dated NA pertaining to adherence of terms of conditions laid down by AICTE for programmes of MBA/MCA/Travel and Tourism, duly notarized and signed by NA, Registrar submitted to the Commission by hand dated NA.
5. The Higher Educational Institution shall not offer any M.Phil/Ph.D Programme through distance learning mode in compliance to clause 11 of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil. /Ph.D. Degrees) Regulations, 2016.
6. The HEI shall establish Examination Centre within the territorial jurisdiction of the HEI subject to condition laid down in clause 7 (i) to (v) of section 13 in Part-IV.
7. In case, Higher Educational Institution fails to comply with the conditions of recognition, appropriate punitive action(s), as per provisions of the UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments, shall be taken by the Commission.
8. The Maulana Azad National Urdu University shall adhere to the policy of territorial jurisdiction as specified in Annexure – IV of the UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017.

ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Gochibowli, Hyderabad-500032. Andhra Pradesh for Secondary(B.Ed-Distance Education) course of two year duration with an annual intake of 500 (Hundred) Students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the University, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Gochibowli, Hyderabad-500032. Andhra Pradesh for conducting Secondary(B.Ed-Distance Education) course of two year duration with an annual intake of 500(Hundred) students under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated,13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - i) The University shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - ii) The University will ensure that the core faculty at the Headquarters level should comprise of one Professor, one Reader and four Lecturers are in position for an intake of 500 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

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4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / bodies, State Government etc, as applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
7. If the University contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.



Open and Distance Education System in the country is contributing a lot in expansion of Higher Education and for achieving target of Gross Enrolment Ratio, without compromising on quality. Non recognition/non equivalence of degrees of Open and Distance Learning (ODL) institutions for the purpose of promotion/employment and pursuing higher education may prove a deterrent to many aspiring students and will ultimately defeat the purpose of Open and Distance Education.

Accordingly, the Degrees/Diplomas/Certificates awarded for programmes conducted by the ODL institutions, recognized by the erstwhile DEC/UGC, in conformity with UGC Notification on Specification of Degrees should be treated as equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Degree/Diploma/Certificate of the traditional Universities/Institutions in the country.

UGC has notified *UGC (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017* in the official Gazette on **23/06/2017**. As per UGC (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 under Part-I (2)(p), the programmes in engineering, medicine, dental, pharmacy, nursing, architecture, physiotherapy and such other programmes which require hands-on training are not permitted to be offered under Open and Distance Learning mode.

1. About Maulana Azad National Urdu University

Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) is a Central University, established in 1998 by an Act of Parliament with all India jurisdiction. The headquarters and main campus of the University is in Hyderabad, spread over 200 acres. MANUU is recognized as a major higher education service provider across the country through regular and distance mode programmes in Urdu medium. The Academic activities of the University commenced with distance education programmes in 1998 and regular programmes in 2004.

The University is named after Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, a scholar par excellence, a prolific writer, an inimitable orator, a great freedom fighter, a visionary of the post independent Indian education system and an architect of technical and scientific education in Independent India.



Vision

To provide access to quality education through Urdu medium, while adhering to the inclusive policy.

Mission

To empower socially, economically and educationally marginalized sections of the society so that they are brought into the mainstream, and thereby contribute to the socio-economic



development of the nation through ODL and regular modes of education.

Mandate

The Mandate of the University is:

- To promote and develop the Urdu language.
- To impart education and training in vocational and technical subjects through the medium of Urdu.
- To provide wider access to people desirous of pursuing programmes of higher education and training in Urdu medium through teaching on the campus as well as through distance mode and
- To focus on women's education.

Schools and Departments of the University

In pursuit of its vision and mission, the University has established Seven (7) School of Studies and 20 Departments of the studies to impart various academic programmes under regular mode. The University established 02 satellite campuses at Lucknow (UP) and Budgam near Srinagar (J&K). Apart from these Satellite Campuses, 17 Off Campus Institutions are functioning across India. About 6,000 students are pursuing various programmes in regular mode.

2. Directorate of Distance Education (DDE)

Every aspirant of education cannot afford to go to the Universities/Colleges to pursue his/her goals in education through regular/ campus mode. Distance Mode of Education is a tool for providing education by taking it to the doorstep of the aspirants. It reaches the unreached. Distance Mode of Education known as Open Distance Learning (ODL) is more suitable and apt for those who want to improve their knowledge and qualification by staying at home or by doing their daily routine/professional work. It requires to attend a few classes at their respective Learner Support Centres (LSCs) opted by them.



The Directorate of Distance Education offers various academic programmes in distance mode and operates through a network of 9 Regional Centres (RCs) and 5 Sub-Regional Centres (SRCs) and around 155 Learner Support Centres (LSCs) catering to around Fifty Thousand students at their doorsteps.

The Instructional Media Centre (IMC), Centre for Information Technology (CIT), Directorate of Translation and Publications (DTP) and Centre for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA) support the Directorate of Distance Education academically and technically to enrich the programmes under Distance Education. The University's Instructional Media Centre prepares video lectures to provide anytime, anywhere learning environment to the learners through its dedicated IMC YouTube channel accessible at <https://www.youtube.com/imcmanuu> and <https://www.youtube.com/c/IMCMANUU/videos> A large repository of audio-visual educational programmes has already been prepared by the Media Centre and new lessons are regularly produced and uploaded. Soft copies of Self Learning Material (SLM) are also being provided to the learners through University's website at weblink (<http://manuu.edu.in/dde/self-learning-material>).

In its endeavor to make ODL programmes more vibrant and to enhance quality for the benefit of the ODL learners, Directorate of Distance Education (DDE) has introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for UG & PG programmes. As per UGC-DEB regulations, the curriculum of various ODL programmes has been revised and synchronized with that of regular mode. Accordingly, the SLMs are being prepared. Directorate of Distance Education (DDE) has vigorously started adopting Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in its academic and administrative functioning. Admissions to all Directorate of Distance Education (DDE)



programmes are now being conducted through on-line mode only. To improve communication between Directorate of Distance Education (DDE) and learners, SMS facility is now being extensively used to send alerts to students about various aspects of programme delivery such as Course Registration, Dispatch of SLMs, Assignments etc.

11. Bachelor of Education Programme*

The Bachelor of Education programme, generally known as B.Ed., is a professional programme that prepares teachers for upper primary (classes VI-VIII), secondary (classes IX-X) as well as senior secondary (Classes XI-XII) levels.

The Bachelor of Education programme (B.Ed.) in ODL mode, is a professional programme for in-service teachers, a second degree in teacher education, primarily intended for upgrading the professional competence of working teachers in the upper primary, secondary schools and senior secondary level who have entered the profession without formal secondary teacher training. It aims at preparing in-service



teachers for the secondary stage of education, in accordance with the notification of the NCTE with regard to minimum qualification for recruitment as a teacher. The programme shall use blended learning modality for design, development, and delivery of the programme.

The programme also provides opportunities for sharing experiences gained by teachers. It enables teachers to select and organize learning experiences according to the requirement of learners. In addition, it provides knowledge and understanding of areas such as latest pedagogies, educational evaluation, school management, use of

ICT in education etc.

11.1. Objectives of the Programme

- I. To understand the nature of the learning process.
- II. To systematize experiences and strengthen the professional competencies of teachers.
- III. To imbibe knowledge and develop an understanding of the methods and approaches of organising learning experiences of secondary school students.
- IV. To develop skills required in selecting and organising learning experiences.
- V. To develop skills involved in dealing with the academic and personal problems of learners.
- VI. To acquire knowledge and develop an understanding of the various procedures and techniques of evaluation and their classroom applications.
- VII. To develop skills involved in selecting, developing, and using evaluation tools.
- VIII. To acquire knowledge and develop an understanding of various aspects of school management.
- IX. To develop competencies for organising various instructional and student support activities.
- X. To develop appreciation of the role of teachers in prevailing socio-cultural and educational system.

11.2. Recognition by NCTE & UGC-DEB

The B.Ed. programme is recognized by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) and UGC-Distance Education Bureau (DEB) vide communication letters F.SRC/NCTE/SRC/APP 1960/B.Ed-AI-(DE)/2018-19-985556 dated 13th November 2018 and F. No: 1-18/ 2018 (DEB-I) dt. 31/12/2018 respectively.

11.3. Duration of the Programme

The minimum duration of the programme is **two** academic sessions/years. However, the maximum period allowed for completion of the programme is five years.

12. Admission

12.1. Eligibility

The Bachelor of Education programme, generally known as B.Ed., is a professional programme that prepares teachers for upper primary (classes VI-VIII), secondary (classes IX-X) as well as senior secondary (classes XI-XII) levels. The Bachelor of Education programme (B.Ed) in ODL mode, is a professional programme for in-service teachers, a second degree in teacher education, primarily intended for upgrading the professional competence of working teachers in the upper primary, secondary schools and senior secondary level who have entered the profession without formal secondary teacher training. It aims at preparing in-service teachers for the secondary stage of education, in accordance with the notifications of the NCTE with regard to minimum qualifications for recruitment as a teacher (Preamble, NCTE B.ED (ODL) Norms and Standards, 2014).

The University follows the eligibility criteria prescribed by NCTE under B. Ed (ODL) Norms & Standards, 2014. Clause 4.2 of the said regulation reads as under.

The following categories are eligible to be the students of B.Ed. (ODL)

- (i) Trained in-service teachers in elementary education.
- (ii) Candidates who have completed a NCTE recognized teacher education programme through face-to-face mode.
- (iii) The reservation and relaxation in marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government/State Government, whichever is applicable.

Apart from the above,

- (iv) Candidates with at least fifty percent (50%) marks either in bachelor's degree and/or in the master's degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/Commerce/Humanities, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto from any UGC recognized University are eligible.
- (v) Candidates must have studied URDU as a subject or medium of instruction up to 10th or its equivalent or above, as the mandate of the university is to impart education through Urdu Medium, which is its special character.

1. Diploma in early childhood education programmes leading to Diploma in Pre-school Education (DPSE)

3. Bachelor of elementary teacher education programme leading to Bachelor of Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) degree.
4. Diploma in physical education programme leading to Diploma in Physical Education (D. P.Ed.)
5. Bachelor of physical education programme leading to bachelor's in physical education (B.P.Ed.)
6. Diploma in arts education (Visual Arts) programme leading to Diploma in Arts Education (Visual Arts)
7. Diploma in arts education (Performing Arts) programme leading to Diploma in Arts Education (Performing Arts)

Note: Apart from the above, programmes with older nomenclatures like D.Ed., TTC, UPT, etc duly recognized by NCTE as face-to-face teacher education programmes may also be considered for admission in B.Ed.

12.3. Process of Admission

- (I) Admissions are based on the merit list of Entrance Test conducted by MANUU.
- (II) Online application forms are available on the University website at <https://manuu.coe.in/ddeadmission/>
- (III) While filling up application forms, candidates shall upload soft copy of all required documents.
- (IV) If selected, the original documents will be verified at the time of admissions.
- (V) The candidate will pay **registration fee through online mode only** while filling-up the application form.
- (VI) Registration fee: Rs.1,000/-

Note: Registration fee once paid shall not be refunded. However, in case of double transactions, university may refund the excess fee received after verifying the claim. *The candidates, claiming to be coming under the reserved category, will have to support their claims with relevant documents while filling up the Application Forms, which will be verified at the time of admissions. If registration form is not complete in every aspect, ipso facto it wil stand cancelled.*

12.4. Entrance Test



Entrance Test will be conducted on the specified date and centers. Hall tickets can be downloaded from the University website at- <https://manuucoe.in/ddeadmission/> using username and password provided by the University at the time of filling-up the application form.

Admissions are given only on the basis of merit list of Entrance Test conducted by MANUU. The provisional admissions to the programme shall be given to the candidates subject to their ranks in Entrance Test and on production of proof of eligibility at the time of document verification. The number of seats at each programme Centre is 50 only. The University has the right to conduct or change the examination center of the candidates without assigning any reason thereof.

The total fee for B.Ed. Programme for two academic sessions/years is Rs. 39000/- for open Category Candidates and Rs.27000/- for SC/ST/PWD/EWS/ Women & Transgender category candidates.

The candidates will have to pay the fee through online mode at the time of provisional admission. If a candidate fails to pay the fee within the prescribed time, his/her admission will be deemed to have been cancelled.

12.6. Refund of Fee

The Programme fee shall be refunded as per the University norms as mentioned above

12.7. Re-registration

If a student fails to complete the programme within the stipulated maximum 5 years period, he/she has to Re-register in the programme, the details of which are as follows:

- i. For Re-Registration with Self Learning Material (SLM), fee shall be same as given in above table (12.5) for each year, he/she wants to appear in the exam.
- ii. For Re-Registration without Self Learning Material (SLM), fee shall be as follows:

12.8. Instructional System

The B.Ed. programme instructional system includes the multi-media approach, i.e., self-instructional print material, audio/video lessons, assignments, counseling sessions and practical work in schools and workshops.

- (i) **Printed Material:** The self-learning materials in printed form for both theory and practical components of the programme shall be provided. The print material for each course shall be in the form of blocks. Each block will consist of 3-5 units. The Self Learning Material (SLM) shall be sent by registered post. The university shall not be responsible for loss or delay by the postal department.



- (ii) **Audio and Visual Lessons:** The audio and video lessons are supplementary material for the enhancement of understanding of the subject. They will be used during counseling



and workshop sessions at respective programme centres.

- (iii) **Assignments:** As per the NCTE Regulations, assignments are an integral and compulsory part of the instructional system. There are three tutor-marked assignments for each theory course. These assignments are to be submitted to the respective programme centres in accordance with the prescribed schedule given in the programme guide.
- (iv) **Counselling and Workshop:** The counseling and workshop sessions will be held at respective programme centres during the scheduled time mentioned in the Academic Calendar.

Counselling: Academic counselling session shall be spread over the entire duration of the programme and be conducted on a regular basis depending on the needs and convenience of the learners. The academic and personal problems related to the course shall be discussed in the counselling sessions. The counselling sessions shall be utilized for providing personalized guidance to the learners regarding content difficulty, field work, teaching practice, projects, assignments, dissertations, time management, study skills etc. There shall be one academic counselling session (one each semester) of 36 study hours (6 days including Saturday and Sunday).

Workshop: In the workshop, the learners shall acquire competencies and skills which are required by a teacher or teacher educator. Therefore, they shall be engaged in certain activities as individuals or as groups, The Study Centres shall also make arrangement for practice teaching in classroom and in the preparation of teaching aids, research tools, worksheets, course units, assignments and assessment rubrics, The learners shall be given sufficient opportunities to practice what they are supposed to do in the classrooms. There shall be one workshop of 3 days duration in each semester.

13. Important Instructions

- I. Attendance in both academic counseling and workshop sessions is mandatory.
- II. If a candidate fails to attend the academic counseling and workshop or any of them, his/her hall ticket to appear in examinations will not be issued.
- III. All activities related to B.Ed. Programme such as counseling classes, workshop sessions, assignments etc., will be organized at their respective programme centres only.
- IV. **Request of student-teachers to attend the B.Ed. programme related activities at centres other than their allotted centres shall not be considered under any circumstances.**



- V. *The Case of B.Ed. Programme is Sub-Judice. Admissions to the B.Ed. Programme is subject to the outcome of W.P.No.18469/2018.

14. Evaluation

The system of evaluation for both theory and practical work is as follows:

14.1. Theory

Evaluation of theory courses comprises following aspects:

- I. Self-evaluation exercises within each unit of study (non-credit).
- II. Continuous evaluation in the form of periodic compulsory assignments. This carries a weightage of 30% for each course. There shall be 3 assignments per course.
- III. The term-end examination has a weightage of 70% of the total for each course.

14.2. Practicals

Evaluation of practical courses comprises following aspects:

- I. Continuous evaluation of school-based activities and teaching practice.
- II. Evaluation of internship.
- III. Evaluation of performance in workshop-based activities.

15. Students' Support Services

For providing support to its individual learners, the University has established 20 B.Ed. Programme Centres throughout the country. These Programme Centres are coordinated by the respective Programme Centre coordinators. These Programme Centres function under the respective Regional/Sub-Regional Centres. At the programme Centres, the learners interact with the Academic Counselors as well as their peer group, refer books in the library, watch/listen to Video/Audio Cassettes & DVD's etc. Workshop activities are also conducted at these centres. For any queries, they can contact their respective Programme Centre Coordinator.

16. Structure of the Entrance Test Paper for B.Ed.

The Entrance Test paper will consist of two parts A & B. The total number of questions will be 100 and each question will carry one mark. Thus, maximum marks allotted to the test is 100. The



maximum time for the Entrance Test, consisting of two parts A & B, is Two Hours.

5. The selection of an LSC at the stage of filling in application form shall be provisional because the University has right to terminate the MoU with an LSC due to any reason.
