Speaking on the significance of the policy, he said with this policy Science students can even learn arts and management without disturbing their core subject and vice-versa. The success of this policy is that it is being communicated properly to the people and in this endeavor MANUU's IMC is also working hard, he pointed out.

Earlier, Prof. Siddiqui Mohammad Mahmood, Registrar I/c, welcomed the chief guest and briefed about the mandate of MANUU. He was also the moderator of the inaugural session. To develop e-content on NEP is a historic decision, he remarked.
