

Sherwani Centre for Deccan Studies, MANUU Hyderabad, external members could not attend the meeting due to some pre-occupied schedule.

At the outset, the Chairman extended cordial & warm welcome to all the members of School Board. The agenda items were discussed thoroughly and the members resolved following issues:

Confirmation of the Minutes of 2nd School Board Meeting of School of Computer Science & Information Technology:

The Chairman informed that minutes of the 2nd School Board meeting of Computer Science & Information Technology held on 18/02/2017 were circulated among the school board members. Minor changes were received from the school board members and

subsequently incorporated in 2nd School Board minutes of the meeting. The school board confirmed the minutes of 2nd School Board held on 18/02/2017 (Annexure3.1).

Items for Consideration:

3.2 To Consider the 11th Board of Study (BOS) minutes of the meeting, Dept. of CS & IT:

A meeting of 11th BOS was held on 07.11.2017 at 3.00pm in Conference Hall CS&IT Department, MANUU Hyderabad. The Chairman informed that minutes of 11th BOS were circulated among the members and since no comments were received hence minutes are confirmed (Annexure3.2).

3.3 To Consider the 3rd DRC minutes of meeting:

The board members discussed thoroughly the minutes of 3rd Departmental Research Committee (DRC) meeting held on 15/09/2017 and resolved (Annexure 3.3).

3.4 To Consider the AICTE Revised Curriculum of B.Tech Computer Science with effective from academic year 2018-19:

The board members discussed new curriculum of AICTE pertaining to B.Tech (Computer Science) w.e.f. academic year 2018-19 thoroughly. New curriculum is designed with more emphasis on laboratory & practical oriented approach. Number of hours for laboratories & practical are increased in revised AICTE curriculum. Three weeks induction program has been introduced in B.Tech first semester before commencement of regular classes as a compulsory component. The board members suggested minor modifications in terms of opting professional core courses, choices of professional and open electives from the given pool of electives. The board members also agreed that since a student need to earn 160 credits to be eligible to get Under Graduate degree in Engineering.

However, a student will be eligible to get Under Graduate degree with Honours, if he/she completes an additional 20 more credits which could be acquired through MOOCs (Annexure 3.4).

3.5 CBCS based Credit distribution effective for batches admitted from 2016-17 academic years:

In view of University guidelines and CBCS implementation, department of CS&IT has already adopted University CBCS course curriculum and following credit distribution for B.Tech (Computer Science), M.Tech (Computer Science) and MCA with minor modification for the batches admitted from 2016-17 academic year is discussed and resolved to be incorporated in CBCS structure of the University (Annexure 3.5).

Other Agenda Item with permission of chair

In view of IT Workshop using Sci/MATLAB introduced in new curriculum of AICTE for B.Tech third semester students, the external board members suggested and emphasized the need to procure the licensed software of MATLAB and SPSS in CS&IT department for hands on practice in order to understand & learn the theoretical and technical aspect.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair & board members.
