Pattern and structure will be as per AICTE model curriculum with minor subject adjustments (clubbing/splitting/shifting), whereas the contents will be analyzed i.e., data to be added/pruned depending upon the availability of laboratories and resources.

First year (1st and 2nd semester) will be common for all courses and they are placed in two pools. Total credits for all six semesters will be 121.

Prof. V. Kamakshi Prasad suggested for an exclusive MANUU Regulations (Academic and Examinations) to be prepared for the Technical courses (Diploma & Degree).

6.3 To review the status of programs (Diploma in Apparel Technology and Diploma in Automobile Engineering) at MANUU Polytechnics Kadapa and Cuttack

The committee reviewed thoroughly the current student enrollment status for both the programs (Diploma in Apparel Technology and Diploma in Automobile Engineering) at MANUU Polytechnics Kadapa and Cuttack and suggested to keep both the courses on hold (in abeyance) from the academic year 2020-21 because of poor response of students and huge investment for the establishment of laboratories and infrastructure.

Board suggested starting of Diploma in Computer Science and Engineering at both the MANUU Polytechnics (Kadapa and Cuttack) based on the request from the local community and stakeholders.

After approval of AC and EC meetings a proposal may be sent to the UGC to start Diploma in Computer Science and Engineering in both the Polytechnics (Kadapa and Cuttack).
