CSSEIP proposes 6 PhD seats in SEIP in the next Academic year.

- b.) UGC in its guidelines and objective of the Centres, clearly states that centre would offer courses at Post Graduation level and eventually it would start offering even M.A., M.Phil and Ph.D in thrust area of the

centre. Centre proposes to offer certain Generic Elective Courses under CBCS) in the core area of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy. These courses will be offered at Post Graduation level.

- c.) The following courses have been proposed by the faculty members of the Centre to offer Generic Elective Courses for M.A from the Academic Year 2019-2020.

Course 1: Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy: An Introduction (Dr.A.Nageswara Rao)

Course 2: Social Groups in India: Marginalization and Exclusion. (Dr.K.M.Ziyauddin)

Course 3: Socially Excluded Communities in India: Perspectives for Inclusive Policies. (Dr.S.Abdul Thaha)

CWS-Standing Committee approved it.


















1. It is brought to the notice of the members of School Board by the Director (I/c), ACSSEIP that UGC has given extension to the Centre

till 31.03.2019. After detailed discussions, it was resolved that, in case, UGC fails to give extension to this Centre under the existing plan scheme, then the University may consider absorbing the Centre in the University and make it a full-fledged Research Centre. The rationale of this recommendation was to promote the research activities in the University which is hallmark of any institute of higher learning.

2. Prof. Shahid, Dept. of Social Work, observes that the faculty members of ACSSEIP may be allowed for Research Supervision in concerned department of studies in the SA&SS, subject to their eligibility as research supervisor as per the Ph.D Regulations, MANUU. The School board discussed and resolved to recommend the same.
