MANUU to reopen for all research scholars from February 15

Hyderabad: The Maulana Azad National Urdu University's (MANUU) administration on Wednesday introduced that it has determined to reopen the campus for research scholars from February 15. The newest choice has been taken as a part of its course of to slowly reopen campus, in compliance with the rules issued by University Grants Commission (UGC).

In the second part, all research scholars registered in varied departments will likely be permitted to report to the varsity on February 15, stated a press launch from MANUU. Earlier, within the first part, the campus was reopened solely for research scholars from the School of Sciences and School of Technology from January 27 this yr. The hostel facility will likely be out there to eligible boarders solely, acknowledged a press launch from MANUU on Wednesday.

It added that college students availing short-term hostel facility and people who availed it for 4 years throughout their Ph.D programs are nevertheless not eligible for the identical. Earlier int the day, the scholars fraternity from Maulana Azad National Urdu University MANUU urged the varisty's administration to reopen campus "at the earliest" whereas complying with UGC pointers.

"The students want return to academic activities on campus as they have already enrolled for various programs, and are currently attending online classes," stated former president of Students Union Umar Faruq Quadri. He added that the continuing COVID-19 pandemic has affected the lives of everybody but it surely college students more durable.

An announcement from MANUU college students added that the college administration has been requested to resume offline courses by the tip of February in order to decrease losses to college students. "If university administration fails to reopen the university with due arrangements and precautions, we students will be left with no other option but to enter the university, and occupy hostels," it added.
