## Webinar on Gender reporting in Urdu Media to be organised at MANUU

Hyderabad, Mar 22 (UNI) The Centre for Women's Studies and Dept of Journalism and Mass communication, Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) will organise a two day webinar with Media Leaders on "Gender Reporting in Urdu Media - Opportunities & Challenges" on March 24 & 25 from 1100 hours am to 1400 hours online, in collaboration with Population First supported by UNFPA and Norwegian Embassy.

According to Prof Shahida Murtaza, Director, Centre for Women Studies, the media leaders from Urdu media are being involved to have a conversation on the status of reporting through the gender lens as well as on having more gender equal newsrooms in Urdu Media, identify opportunities and challenges in promoting gender sensitive reporting and gender inclusive organizations, a release here said on Tuesday.

This media consultation is expected to provide an opportunity to understand the status of gender reporting in Urdu media and identify steps to promote gender sensitive stories in Urdu media.
