**Resolution 1:**

**Al Beruni Centre for the Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy (ACSSEIP)**

1. Future Plans of the Centre for approval of the Advisory Committee (major research programs and activities) were discussed at length by the experts. The Committee approved the following proposed minor research projects which can be conducted with the funding available under Contingency Grant of the Centre:
  - i. "Awareness level among Muslims about schemes and programmes by Government of Telangana State" by Dr. A Nageswara Rao, Asst.Prof. ACSSEIP
  - ii. "Residential Schools for Muslims in Telangana State: A Preliminary Analysis" by Dr. K M Ziyauddin, Asst.Prof. ACSSEIP
  - iii. "Audit of Urdu Medium Schools in Hyderabad" by Dr. S. Abdul Thaha, Asst.Prof. ACSSEIP
2. It was also resolved that the Centre should take research studies not only on Socio-economic and political status of Muslims in India and other states but also undertake Impact analysis of all the Reports, Policies, Schemes related with Minorities in India.
3. It was also resolved that the Centre should explore the possibility to work closely with the State Governments for effective programme implementation policies and schemes related with marginalised sections of the society.
4. The Committee has also resolved the followings:
  - a. The Centre may prepare reference material on a series of topics related to social exclusion and public policy in English, Urdu and Telugu languages for public awareness.
  - b. The Centre should continue to organise national/ international Conferences, Symposia, Seminars, Workshops, Round Tables, Lecture Series, Networking, Sensitisation programmes, etc., for promotion and dissemination of knowledge regarding social exclusion/ public policies.
  - c. The Centre may enter into MoUs with National and International organisations and universities for carrying out collaborative research work and exchange programmes of faculty/research scholars.

**Resolution 4:**

After detailed discussion, following suggestions were made to Centre for upcoming sessions:

1. The Centre should continue to engage in collecting the empirical data on the socio-economic conditions of Dalits, Tribals, and religious minorities and submit to the government agencies for better policy formulations and implementation.
2. The Centre should aim to emerge as best Data Bank in the country for future researchers and policy planners on minorities.
3. The Centre may offer Generic Courses for Post-Graduate Students of MANUU.
