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Madrasas asked to promote women education Online Workshop on Leadership Development concludes at MANUU

Prof. Syed Ainul Hasan, Vice Chancellor, Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) expressed the view while delivering presidential address in the valedictory of the Online Workshop "Leadership Development" yesterday on July 30, 2021.
