**Sub: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 40<sup>th</sup> Emergent Academic Council held on 29.10.2020 – Reg.**

The members of the Academic Council resolved to confirm the Minutes of the 40<sup>th</sup> Emergent Meeting of the Academic Council held on 29.01.2020. The Academic Council also noted the Action Taken Report of the meetings.

**Item No. 40.02.01**

**Sub: To consider the release of notification for B.Ed admission for the academic year 2020-21 at CTE Darbhanga in the light of the minutes of 289<sup>th</sup> meeting of the ERC, NCTE held on 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021 wherein the decision of restoration of the B.Ed. programme of MANUU at CTE Darbhanga has been taken – Reg.**

The Academic Council considered and approved to process the admissions of B.Ed at CTE, Darbhanga based on the decision of restoration of recognition of the B.Ed

programme of MANUU at CTE Darbhanga taken up in the 289<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Eastern Regional Committee , National Council for Teacher Education. The minutes of the 289<sup>th</sup> meeting of ERC are available on the NCTE website.

Registrar was assigned to send a gratitude letter to the Regional Director, NCTE for restoration and recognition order for B.Ed course at CTE Darbhanga with an annual intake of 100 for 2020-21 and to give prior information to the NCTE that the University is initiating the process of admissions of B.Ed at CTE Darbhanga for 2020-21 in the light of restoration accorded by the NCTE.


The Registrar appraised the members that in the 38<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council held on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2020 it has been resolved that the admission for B.Ed against 100 seats at CTE Darbhanga will be done after restoration of the approval by the NCTE and the same has been incorporated in the Admission Prospectus 2020-21. The entrance test was also conducted for admission in B.Ed Darbhanga and the admissions are kept on hold for recognition and restoration of course by NCTE.

The Competent Authority constituted the committee with Dean, Education and Training as the Chairman, Director, Directorate of Admissions as the Convenor, Dean Academics and Deputy Dean, P&D as members of the committee. The committee in its meeting decided not to give sliding option to the students admitted in CTE Darbhanga for the following reasons

- (i) The students already enrolled four months back have completed the micro teaching and appearing for the semester end examinations in the first week of April 2021.
- (ii) The Registrar & the Dean, school of Education & Training conducted the meeting on 18.02.2021 with the Principals of CTEs and Head, Department of Education unanimously opined that admission of students at CTE-Darbhanga should be taken up without giving any sliding option to the already admitted students as this would upset the teaching –learning process of the existing as well as new batch.
- (iii) Allowing any students who have already been admitted in the first semester classes for the last four months period is not desirable in the larger academic interest.

The members of the Academic Council also proposed that Dean, School of Education & Training, Director, Directorate of Admissions, HoD, Department of Education and Training, Principal CTE Darbhanga, CoE and the Deputy Dean, P&D shall prepare the Admission schedule , Academic Calendar and Examination schedule.
