At the outset, the Chairperson of the School Board welcomed all the members and offered his sincere gratitude for making it convenient to attend the meeting. Subsequently, he introduced the new external member Prof. Jasim Ahmad, Professor, JMI to all the School Board members and requested them to give their introduction.

As all the points could not be discussed in the School Board meeting held on 28.05.2021, a continuous meeting was held on 02.06.2021.

**Item No. 1: Confirmation of the minutes of the last School Board meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2020.**

The Chairperson highlighted the main point which had been discussed in the last School Board meeting held on 5th July, 2020, and said that the Minutes were circulated among all the members and no observations / comments have been received. The members confirmed the Minutes.

**Item No. 2: Approval of Minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> Advisory Committee Meeting conducted by Centre for Professional Development of Urdu Medium Teachers (CPDUMT), MANUU held on 02.07.2020.**

On the request of the Dean, Prof. Abdul Sami Siddiqui, Director, CPDUMT, has presented the Minutes of the Advisory Committee of CPDUMT and requested the members to recommend the enhancement/increase in the annual budget for CPDUMT programmes as the cost of the programme has enhanced during previous years and the CPDUMT has been facing crunch of funds.

He has also requested for expanding the scope of CPDUMT programmes and to bring Urdu Medium College and University teachers along with Urdu Medium School and Madrasa teachers under the scope of the programme.

It was resolved to recommend for suitable increase / enhancement of Annual budget for CPDUMT programmes. It was also recommended to constitute a Committee comprising the following members to examine whether the Urdu Medium College / University teachers may be included in the scope of CPDUMT programmes as per the mandate of CPDUMT:

If the above Committee recommends, as per the mandate of CPDUMT, efforts will be made to see that 80% scope of the CPDUMT programmes will be for the School / Madrasa teachers and the remaining 20% of the scope will be for the College / University teachers.

**Item No. 3: Approval of Minutes of Board of Studies of Department of Education and Training held on 03.05.2021.**

The Chairperson of the School Board requested Prof. Mohd. Moshahid, Head, Department of Education & Training to present the salient features of Board of Studies meeting of Department of Education and Training which was held on 03.05.2021. Prof. Mohd. Moshahid described the Agenda items. He has mentioned that the Minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting which was held on 18.09.2019 were confirmed by all the BoS members. He has also mentioned that the BoS members confirmed the adoption of two credit courses for awareness about Research and Publication Ethics (REP) to be made compulsory for all Ph.D. Programmes. He has stated that it was resolved in the Board of Studies meeting that as per the resolutions made in the 37th Meeting of Academic Council (held on 30.01.2020) two students shall be included as Special Invitees in the Board of Studies (one male student and one female student). These two students shall be the First rank holders of M. Ed. and Ph.D. programmes respectively.

Further, the School Board members suggested that their ranks in the Entrance Test may be taken into consideration while including them as Special Invitees. The Chairperson of the School Board has

suggested that the duration of these students as Special Invitees shall be only of one year.

**Item No. 4: Eligibility criteria for admission into B.Ed. Programme in the School of Education and Training.**

The eligibility criteria for admission into B.Ed. Programme which was approved in the BoS meeting was put before the School Board members. The Chairperson of the School Board further informed the members that all the NCTE norms have been taken up in this criteria for the admission into B.Ed. programme.

In the meeting it was discussed that while applying for admission in B.Ed. programme (for subjects Biological Science, Physical Science, Mathematics, Social Studies and Urdu) some candidates do not opt for the subjects in accordance with the subjects they have studied at graduation level. After qualifying in the Entrance Test and during the time counselling, they are denied for admission for not studying the subjects they have opted in B.Ed. programme at the graduation level. For this, they confront by saying that their application should have been rejected in the beginning itself for not opting the same subject which they have studied at graduation level.

This point was thoroughly discussed and it was resolved to streamline the procedure as per the recommendation made by the Board of Studies meetings held on 03.05.2021 at 3:00 pm and 02.06.2021 at 1:00 pm.

**Eligibility criteria methodology wise:**

**For Mathematics:**

Candidates with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in

1. B.Sc./B.A. with Mathematics

Or

2. B.E/B.Tech. with mathematics with 55% of marks

Or

3. M.Sc./M.A. in Mathematics with 50% Marks

**For Physical Science:**

Candidates with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in

1. B.Sc. Physical Science with Physics or Chemistry

Or

2. B.E/B.Tech. with Physics and Chemistry subjects with 55% of marks

Or

3. M.Sc. in Physics or Chemistry with 50% Marks

**For Biological Sciences:**

Candidates with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in

1. B.Sc. Biological Science with Zoology or Botany

Or

2. M.Sc. in Zoology or Botany with 50% Marks

**For Social Studies:**

Candidates with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks at graduation level with any one of the subjects History, Geography, Economics, Political Science/Public Administration/Civics, Commerce, Home Science.

Or

P.G. with 50% in any one of the subjects History, Geography, Economics, Political Science/Public Administration/Civics, Commerce, Home Science

**For Urdu:**

Candidates with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in B.A. Urdu.

Or

B.A. with a minimum of 50% of aggregate marks with Urdu as one of the optional/subsidiary subject at graduation level.

Or

M.A. in Urdu with 50% marks.

After a brief discussion on this issue, the School Board members have given their suggestions for the eligibility criteria. The Chairperson noted their suggestions and informed the members that all the norms of NCTE have been taken in this criteria and their suggestions will be considered in the next meeting.

The Chairperson with the permission of the School Board members approved the minutes of Board of Studies and proposed to approve the eligibility criteria for admission in B. Ed. Programme and the minutes have been approved.

**Item No. 5: NCTE Recognition for B.Ed. programmes at CTE Srinagar and CTE Bhopal.**

The School Board members noted that the recognition for B.Ed. Programme at CTE Bhopal was not year restored by the NCTE even after the University has fulfilled all the conditions including the appointment of faculty as per NCTE Norms.

Further, the NCTE-NRC has called for applications from all the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) in Jammu and Kashmir. Accordingly, the University, keeping in view the availability of staff

and infrastructural facilities at CTE Srinagar, has applied for only one Unit (50 students) of B.Ed. Programme at CTE Srinagar. Till date, the recognition from NCTE, NRC for one unit of B.Ed. Programme at CTE Srinagar is awaited.

In this regard, it was resolved to recommend the conduct of Entrance Test for B.Ed. Programme at CTE Bhopal and CTE Srinagar along with Headquarters and other CTEs. However, the admissions in B.Ed. programme at CTE Bhopal and CTE Srinagar will be given only after getting the recognition from NCTE.


**Item No. 6: Any other items with the permission of the Chair.**

The Chairperson proposed for inclusion of the following in B.Ed. programme:

1. Pedagogy of Teaching Computer Science
2. Teacher Education programmes with special emphasis on Value based education programme/ ICT based education programme / Concept green based education programme.

Further, he has suggested that these two items may be first examined in the Board of Studies and they will be considered in School Board in the light of the BoS recommendations.
