US Consulate Hyderabad & RELO officials meet MANUU VC

The US Consulate Hyderabad and Regional English Language Office (RELO), New Delhi officials today visited Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) and held a courtesy meeting with the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Syed Ainul Hasan to explore the academic and cultural collaborations.

According to Prof. Mohammed Abdul Sami Siddiqui, Coordinator Competition thirty one students participated in the preliminary round. Sarath Chandra were the judges for English.
