Maulana Azad, ambassador of National Integrity - MANUU organizes online Symposium

Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) today organized online symposium “Maulana Abul Kalam Azad: An ambassador of National Unity and Integrity” as part of Azad Day Celebrations. Prof. S.M. Rahmatullah, Pro-Vice Chancellor, preside over.

The guest speaker, Prof. Amina Kishore, Former Dean & Professor, Azad Chair, MANUU in her address described Maulana Abul Kalam Azad an advocate of unity. Prof. Mohammad Mohibul Haque, Dept. of Pol. Sc., Aligarh Muslim University said that Maulana Azad and Sir Syed propagated nationalism while keeping the importance of religion along. Maulana Azad had said that religion cannot be a criteria to prove nationality. Prof. Haque termed Maulana Azad's Hindu-Muslim unity as a metaphor of national security.
