SIP Module 2: Physical Health and Related Activities

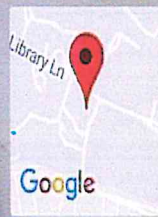

SIP Module 3: Familiarization of Department/ Branch and Innovation

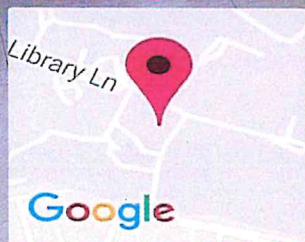

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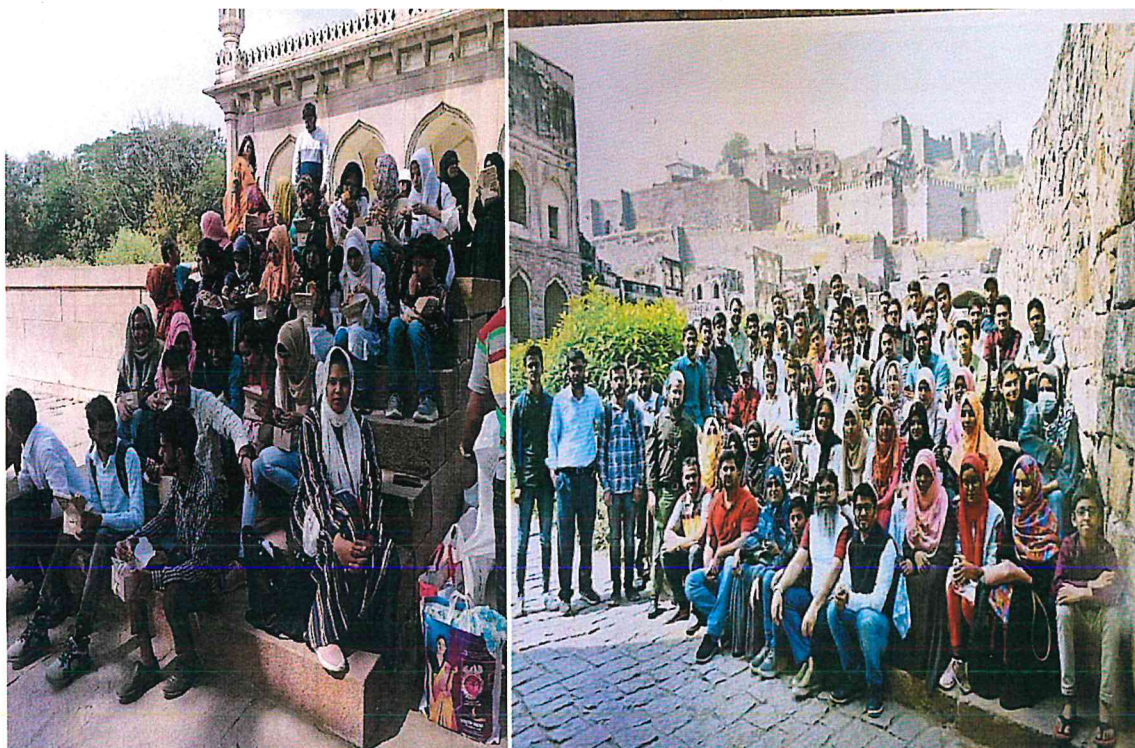


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SIP Module 4: Visit to a Local Area

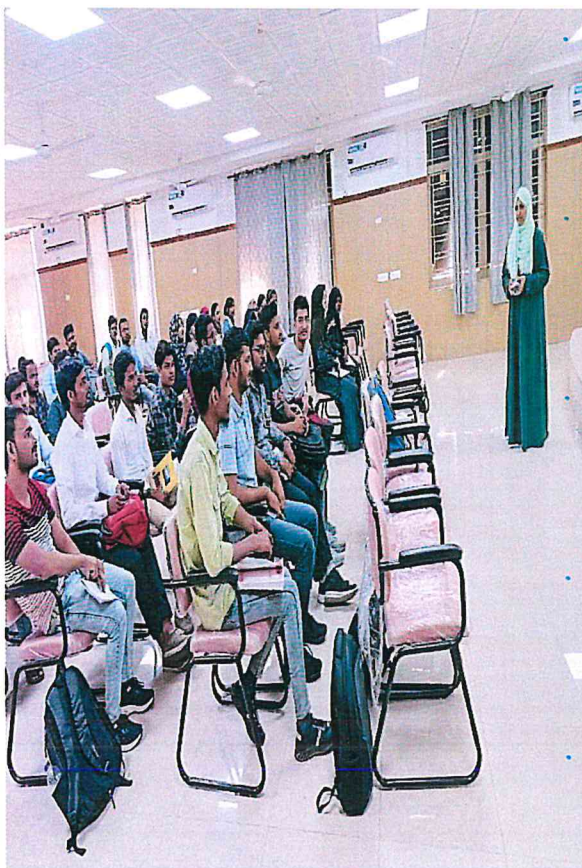
SIP Module 7: Literature / Literary Activities

SIP Module 8: Creative Practices

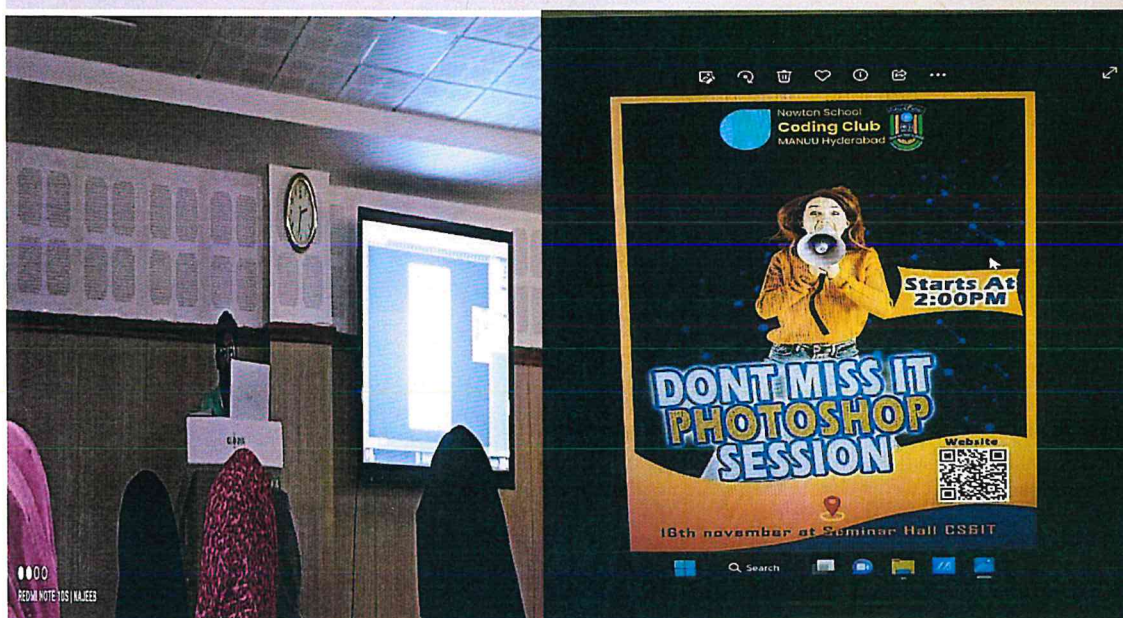

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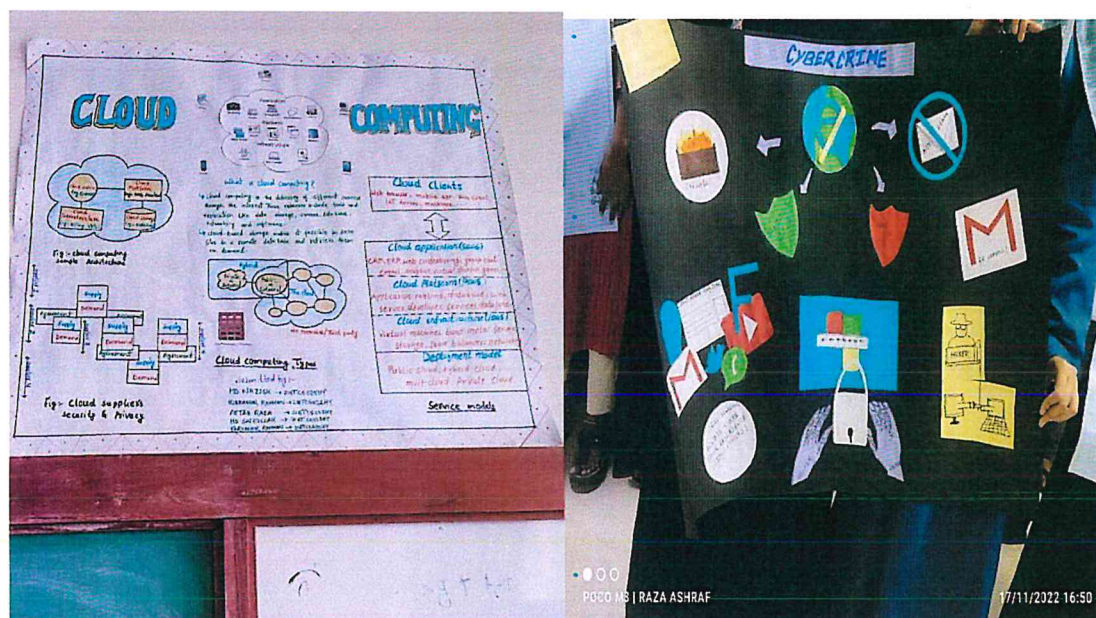


SIP Module 9: Extra Curricular Activities
