Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) is offering admissions in Undergraduate regular courses through Common University Entrance Test (CUET) 2023 for academic session 2023–24. The last date for online registration and submission of application form is March 12, 2023.

According to Prof. M. Vanaja, Director, Directorate of Admissions, the UG courses available are B.A. (General & JMC), B.Com., B.Sc. (MPC, MPCS, ZBC) with Honors and Research along with B.Voc. (MIT & MLT). MANUU is launching four year UG Hons./Research programme from the current academic year 2023-24 in multidisciplinary mode with multiple entry/exit as per NEP-2020.

Meanwhile, MANUU will notify the admissions of regular PG, B.Tech, B.Ed., Diploma in Engineering, D.El.Ed, all certificate and research programmes separately.
