	<p>Specific Elective) is divided into two and renamed as Quantitative Methods I for the 1st semester and Quantitative Methods II for the second semester and labour Economics (MAEC201DST) is removed from 2nd Semester.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In 3rd Semester, Health Economics (Core Paper) is replaced with the Behavioural Economics as core paper, whereas Economics of Education is replaced by the Econometrics I as Discipline Specific Elective. In 4th Semester, Rural Economics is replaced with the Environmental Economics as Discipline Specific Elective, and the existing Econometrics paper is renamed as Econometrics II with the requisite changes in the Syllabus (Annexure-06).
