In addition, three more programmes, i.e., M.A (History), M.A (Hindi) & M.A (Arabic) are awarded recognition vide. F.No.40-11/2022 (DEB-II) (ODL) dated 27.10.2022.

Item No. 47.03.04: MANUU entered fourth Grand Challenges under the Glue Grant Scheme.

The Academic Council noted that under the Glue Grant Scheme, MANUU became a part of three grand challenges (i.e.) Clean Air and Potable Water, Quality Education, Livelihood and Creative Opportunities and Disaster and Climate Resilience and has now has become a part of grand Challenge “Safe and Speed Mobility”.

Item No.47.04.01: Introduction of Master of Technology (M.Tech)-CSE (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) - Part time program under sponsored/ self-finance mode in Dept. of Computer Science and Information Technology.

The Academic Council considered the proposal of introducing Master of Technology-CSE (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) Part Time Program under sponsored/ self-finance mode of 3 years duration with effect from the Academic Year 2023-2024. The Vice Chancellor shall constitute a committee to prepare a detailed report regarding the admission of students of MANUU and outside MANUU and fee Concession to the MANUU students. The Fee structure is to be finalized by the Admission Committee.

Item No. 47.04.02: Introduction of Ph.D. by the following Departments/ Centres in Self-financing mode.

The Academic Council considered the proposal of starting the Ph.D. Programme by the following Departments.

The Academic Council deferred introduction of Self-Financing Ph.D. Programme in Persian.

Item No. 47.04.03: Recommendations of the Sub Committee in respect of EWS Research Policy, Criteria for admissions into ECA/NSS/ NCC/sports quota, PWD Research Policy and Research Guidelines.

The Academic Council adopted UGC Gazette Notification of 7th. November, 2022 and incorporated recommendations of the sub-committee regarding EWS Research Policy, Criteria for admissions into ECA/NSS/ NCC/sports quota, PWD Research Policy and Research guidelines.

In addition, the Academic Council emphasized upon the following:

All permanent faculty members are entitled to supervise PhD scholars as per UGC Guidelines. In case of co-supervisors, the status quo is to be maintained.

Scholars are required to publish at least one research paper before submission of thesis apart from fulfilling the other mandatory UGC requirements.

The JRF holders may be given preference over other candidates appearing for PhD interview.

Part Time PhD under Sponsored/Self-financing mode shall remain in place as per notifications issued from time to time.

In case of registered PhD students joining employment or for any other valid reason, the scholars can be permitted to convert to Part Time extra mural mode, if he/she has completed the prescribed course work, on the recommendation of the RAC, DRC, School Board, and subsequent approval of the Competent Authority.

Students registered as Part Time scholars at the time of admission, shall continue to be governed by rules and regulations already prescribed by the UGC.

In view of the Gazette notification No exemption from Entrance Test is given to M.Phil Students.

However the candidates who qualify for fellowship/scholarship in UGC-NET/UGC-CSIR NET/GATE/CEED and similar National level tests if desirous, may appear in the written test of the Ph.D. entrance examination.

The University will finalize the report on Ph.D. Research Policy and the same will be notified.

Item No. 47.04.04: Introduction of Fashion Technology and Interior Design Programmes in School of Technology in collaboration with SAMANA College of Design Studies

The Academic Council considered to introduce Certificate/Diploma and Under Graduate 4-year degree Programmes in the stream of Fashion Technology and Interior Design in collaboration with SAMANA College of Design Studies. The Course structure will

be as per NEP 2020 duly approved by a committee of experts. The Academic Council authorized the Vice Chancellor to constitute a committee to finalize the course structure.

Item No. 47.04.05: Recommendations of the Committee to implement 4-year Undergraduate Programme under NEP.

The Academic Council considered the draft structure for 4 year Under Graduate Programme as per National Education Policy 2020 from the Academic year 2023-2024 and to adopt the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) scheme in Higher Education Regulations 2021 up to level 9 and subsequently incorporate level 10 later. The following schools in their School Board meetings revised the course structure for 4-year UG Programme as per NEP 2020

- i) School of Arts and Social Sciences
- ii) School of Languages, Linguistics, and Indology
- iii) School of Technology
- vi) School of Commerce and Business Management
- v) School of Sciences
- vi) School of Mass Communication & Journalism.

The Academic Council also resolved that the Committee constituted for implementation of 4 year UG programme as per NEP 2020, shall go through the course structure submitted by the schools and if there is any shortfall the same shall be rectified prior to admitting of students to the academic year 2023-2024.

Item No. 47.04.06: Centre for Urdu Culture Studies to come under School of Languages, Linguistics and Indology and introduction of Ph. D. Programme in CUCS.

The Academic Council resolved to introduce Ph.D. Programme in CUCS from the academic Year 2023-24 with specialization in Urdu Culture, Folk Culture, Folk Literature, Popular Culture, Performing Arts, Fine Arts, Media Culture, Socio-Culture, Customs, Faith, Superstition, Entertainment, Tradition, Rituals, Practices, Habits, Way of life, Arts, and Aesthetics etc. The Academic Council also considered to place Centre for Urdu Culture Studies (CUCS) under School of Languages, Linguistics, and Indology for academic and administrative reasons.

Item No. 47.04.07: Conversion of Ph.D.(JMC) Programme of Mr. Zahoor Hussain Bhat from Full time to Part time

The Academic Council considered the recommendations of the School Board of Mass Communication and for conversion of Ph.D. programme of Mr. Zahoor Hussain Bhat, A210256 (JMC) from Full time to Part time.

Item No. 47.04.08: Introduction of Diploma and Certificate Courses in DDE

The Academic Council considered the proposal of introduction of following Diploma and Certificate courses in DDE.

- (a) Diploma in Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE)



(b) Diploma in School Leadership and Management

However, the title of Diploma in Life Skills for Employability is revised as Diploma in Employability Skills.

The Academic Council considered that 4% marks shall be given as Grace Marks to the candidates of 2018-19 batch students who has a shortfall of 4% to pass as the qualifying marks or grade or CGPA should be entrusted to Regular Programmes.

Item No.47.04.11: Introduction of M. Sc. (two year) programme (in Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology Section from the next academic session 2023-2024.

The Academic Council considered to start M.Sc.(two year) programme (in Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology Section from the next academic session 2023-2024

Initial approval was accorded by the Academic Council. However, a committee is to be constituted with members representing School of Sciences and Social Sciences in order to explore the possibility of introducing the Diploma courses and Ph.D. Programme.

Item No. 47.04.14: Introduction of B.Ed. Special Education at CTE-Bhopal

The Academic Council considered the proposal of introduction of B.Ed. Special Education in learning Disability at CTE Bhopal from the Academic Year 2024-2025 subject to recognition by Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and approval of UGC for sanctioning of three posts one Professor or Associate Professor and two Assistant Professor under the Teacher preparation in Special Education Scheme.

Item No. 47.04.15: Generic elective paper to be offered by Centre for Professional Development of Urdu Medium Teachers (CPDUMT).

The Academic Council considered the proposal of offering generic elective paper “Professional Skills” of one semester through Urdu and English medium for PG Students from the academic year 2023-2024.
