PM Narendra Modi inaugurated three buildings of MANUU via Video conference

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today inaugurated three buildings (School of Commerce & Business Management, Hyderabad, Engineering Workshop, Hyderabad and Polytechnic Building, Cuttak, Odisha) of Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) through video conference at the Maulana Azad Stadium, Jammu.
