Item No. 48.02.04: Award of 95 Crore Project to Prof. Abdul Wahid, Dean School of Technology.

The Academic Council noted the award of 95 Crore Project sanctioned to Prof. Abdul Wahid, Dean School of Technology in Department of CS&IT, MANUU by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India vide letter No.3 (20)/2023,EG-II dated 04.12.2023. The letter accorded administrative approval of the project " A Virtual Reality Based Assistive System for Learning and Assessment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities" with a total Outlay of Rs.9504.67 Lakhs (Ninty Five Crore Four Lakh and Sixty Seven Thousand only) (i.e. MANUU: Rs 62,54,67,000/- + NICSI: Rs. 32,50,00,000) to be completed over a period of 4 years.

Item No. 48.02.05: Allocation of Seed Money for Minor Research Projects 2023-2024

The Academic Council noted the allocation of Rs.50 Lakhs initially by the Competent Authority towards enhancing the research output. Notification inviting proposals from MANUU Regular Faculty was released by the Dean Research and Consultancy. Total of 94 applications were received. Item No. 48.04.01: Extension of Ph.D. programme of Ms. Tahseen Sultana, Ph.D. Scholar, Public Administration

The Academic Council authorised the Registrar to constitute an Expert Committee to evaluate the progress of the Research Work of Ms. Tahseen Sultana in view of her request for further extension of Ph.D. programme beyond 10 years 9 months and submit the recommendations of the committee to the Vice Chancellor. The recommendations of the committee shall be reported in the next Academic Council meeting for consideration.

Item No. 48.04.02: Extension of Ph.D. Programme of Mr. Mohd. Altaf Lone, Ph.D. Scholar, Department of Translation

The Academic Council authorised the Registrar to constitute an Expert Committee to evaluate the progress of the Research Work of Mr. Mohd. Altaf Lone in view of his request for further extension of Ph.D. programme beyond 08 years 4 months and submit the recommendations of the committee to the Vice Chancellor. The recommendations of the committee shall be reported in the next Academic Council meeting for consideration.

Item No.48.04.03: Allotment of special quota for the internal students of MANUU.

The Academic Council has kept **in abeyance** the recommendations of the Committee for allotment of special quota for the internal students of MANUU for admission in PG and Ph.D. Programmes of MANUU in its meeting held on 25th July 2023.

Item No.48.4.04: Amendments in Examination Rules for Regular Programmes

i) Conduct of Special Exam for the students of Final Semester

The Controller of Examinations in the light of the request made by the Deans of Schools recommended the revision of examination rules relating to conduct of Special Examination, discontinuation of award of marks for attendance and Re evaluation Rules.

Conduct of Special Examination:

1. There can be provision for only one Special Exam for the students of final year. Only as an exception, the students who fail in the final even semester and the immediately preceding odd semester (i.e., last odd and last even semesters of a programme) shall get a chance to register for the backlog papers in the **Special Exam** which shall be conducted after the declaration of the final semester results.
2. The Special Exams for final year students shall be conducted at Departmental level and the marks shall be entered in IUMS for declaration of Special Exam Results.
3. The eligibility of students to appear for Special Exams shall be as follows:
 - i. Students who have failed / obtained less than 5 CGPA in the final Odd / Even Semester exams shall be permitted to complete the program.
 - ii. Students shall be permitted to appear in 50% of the courses.
 - iii. The Special Exams shall be only for theory and practical exams. This shall not be applicable for Continuous Internal Assessment/ Projects/ Teaching Practices / Field Visit, etc.
 - iv. Special exams shall be for the current batch of final year students only provided there are no backlog courses in other preceding semesters.
 - v. This shall not apply for improvement examinations.
 - vi. This shall not be applicable to PhD course work exams and other add-on programmes.
 - vii. Students detained due to shortage of attendance shall not be permitted.
 - viii. Students appearing in special exams shall not be eligible for gold medals / university rank certificates etc.
 - ix. Exam Fee for each theory/practical course shall be Rs 100/- per course for the special exam (to be revised from time to time).

The Academic Council considered and approved the recommendations for conduct of Special Examination.

4. Discontinuing award of marks for attendance:

As per the General Examination rules approved in the 26th Academic Council held on 28th April 2017, it was proposed to award 5 marks (out of 30) and 2.5 marks (out of 15) for attendance in each course/subject as part of Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) to all the students in all programs in each semester except Ph.D. Course work.

The Academic Council considered and approved the discontinuing the award of marks for attendance added in CIE Assignment/ Test/ Seminar/ Presentation etc from the Academic Year/ Semester starting in January 2024.

5. Review of Re-evaluation rules:

The Academic Council deferred the proposal of discontinuation of the Re evaluation of answer scripts.

Item No. 48.04.05: Centre for Internal Quality Assurance Annual Reports for the year 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 for submission to UGC-DEB.

The Academic Council resolved to considered and approve the Centre for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA) Annual reports for the year 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 which have been approved in the CIQA meeting held on 29.05.2023 and 17.11.2023. The Academic Council also agreed to submit the Annual Reports to the UGC-DEB duly signed by the Registrar and the Director, DDE.

Item No. 48.04.06: Introduction of Ph.D. Programme in CPDUMT in the area of Language Teaching in Madarsas.

The Academic Council informed the Director CPDUMT to focus on introducing Research programme on Language Teaching in Madarsas. The complete proposal along with syllabus and eligibility criteria for admission into Ph.D. Programme to be forwarded through proper channel to the Competent Authority for approval.

Item No. 48.04.07: Grant of Maternity Leave to the women students enrolled in (UG/PG) Programmes of MANUU.

The Academic Council considered and approved the Rules framed with regard to granting Maternity Leave to the women students pursuing Under Graduate, and Post Graduate Programmes in MANUU and also relaxations /exemptions to the students who are on Maternity Leave.

Item No. 48.04.08: Hostel accommodation Rules and Regulations for International students.

The Academic Council considered and approved the Rules and Regulations framed by the Committee for providing Hostel accommodation for International Students.

Item No. 48.04.09: To consider lateral entry admission into 2nd Year of M.A. (JMC)

The Academic Council considered and approved the proposal of the School Board of Journalism and Mass Communication with regard credit transfer for the students who have obtained any P.G. Diploma in Urdu from Indian Institute of Mass Communication or any other of its centre in M.A. (JMC) 2nd year offered by the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism from the academic year 2024-2025. The School Board of SMCJ approved that the students who have obtained "Any P.G. Diploma from IIMC may be also eligible for Credit transfer into 2nd Year of M.A.(JMC) Course if the student has studied Urdu as one of the subject at 10th/10+2/ Graduation level."

The intake with credit transfer in M.A (JMC) 2nd year will be (10) which will be over and above the intake of the existing intake.

The student who possesses a PG Diploma in Urdu Journalism will be given an extra weight age of 5% Marks while preparing the merit list for admission with credit transfer into M.A. (JMC) 2nd year.

The Reservation Policy and other Guidelines of the University will also be applicable to the additional seats of 10 for admission through Credit Transfer.

Admission Fees and Semester Fees will be applicable as per the existing fee structure of the Department / University.

Item No. 48.04.10: Establishment of Department of Linguistics, Department of Comparative Studies and to introduce Ph.D. in Applied Linguistics.

The Academic Council considered and approved the recommendations made by the School Board, School of Languages, Linguistics & Indology with regard to establishment of Department of Linguistics and Department of Comparative Studies with one Associate professor to be appointed as a Regular faculty in the Department of Comparative studies and one Associate Professor in Applied Linguistics and also to introduce Ph.D. in Applied Linguistics (Self Finance Mode).

Item No. 48.04.11: Conduct of "Continuous Internal Assessment and Evaluation" to be implemented from the next Semester for Regular Programmes.

The Academic Council resolved that an exclusive meeting with the Heads of the Departments/ Deans of School be conducted for finalization of pattern of conduct of Continuous Internal Assessment and Evaluation.

Item No. 48.04.12: Promotion of 2022-2023 batch of Undergraduate students with less CGPA.

The Academic Council considered and approved the promotion of Undergraduate students of batch 2022-2023 with less than 5 CGPA to the next semester to avoid the overlapping of simultaneous running of 3 years CBCS and 4 year NEP Undergraduate Courses *as a one time permission*. The promoted students will however have to write backlog exams in the paper with less than 5 CGPA.

Item No. 48.04.13: To consider to revisit the Admission Policy for admissions in Off Campuses

The Academic Council in the light of marginal low admission in the programmes offered by MANUU at Off Campuses, resolved to constitute a committee to look into the measures to be taken to increase the intake of admissions at off Campuses. The committee shall submit its recommendations at the earliest.

The Academic Council also discussed and decided to develop the Budgam campus, (land allotted by the State Government of Jammu and Kashmir) as early as possible and shift the Regional Centre to the Budgam Campus.

Item No. 48.05.01: Establishment of Start up Incubation center

The Academic Council after detailed deliberations referred the proposal of establishment of Start up Incubation Center to the Committee constituted for implementation of National Innovation and Start up Policy. The recommendations of the committee and the complete proposal to be further referred to two Memorandum of Understanding Committees constituted for Academic matter and other than Academic matters respectively. The recommendations of the Committee will be forwarded to the University Standing Council for furnishing their opinion.

Item No. 48.05.02: To introduce Vocational Programmes at Bhopal Off Campus in the building vacated after shifting to new Campus

The Academic Council authorised the Vice Chancellor to form a three member Committee to explore the possibility of starting Vocational and Skill based Programmes at Bhopal Off Campus.

Item No.48.05.03: Restoration of Departments in School of Sciences

The Academic Council was appraised about the letters sent to the UGC in respect of creation of Science Departments and sanction of posts for Teaching faculty.

The Academic Council considered and resolved to approve the creation of Department of Botany, Department of Chemistry, Department of Physics, and Department of Zoology as the School of Sciences has already started M.Sc. Programmes in Botany, Chemistry, Physics and Zoology from the Academic Year 2023-2024.

Item No. 48.05.04: To start a MANUU Law School in the University

The Academic Council considered and approved to establish MANUU Law School. The Academic Council also noted the initiation made by Prof.Tabrez Ahmad for obtaining approvals from Bar Council of India for starting 3 year.LL.B and 5 year B.A,LL.B(Hons) integrated Programme from the academic year 2024-2025.

Item No. 48.05.05: Composition of School Board of School of Education and Training

The members of the Academic Council suggested the Dean, School of Education and Training to put up the proposal with regard to the composition of School Board of School of Education and Training as per the provisions available in the Statutes of the University.

The Vice Chancellor and the Registrar thanked the members of the Academic Council for attending the meeting Online/Offline.
