

Dr Anita Sable, Incharge PG Programs & Head, Research and Publication Cell, **Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad** and expert in women and law, delivered a lecture. The Program was presided over by Prof. Afroz Alam Head Dept of Political Science MANUU. Prof. Shahida, Professor in DWE & Dir, CWS, MANUU delivered inaugural address, whereas, Prof. Ameena Tahseen, Head of the Department of Women Education, MANNU, in her welcome address emphasized that awareness regarding women’s law is a need of the hour in these changing times to tackle the atrocities against women related issues.

She further highlighted that the Women are discriminated against not only in the womb and childhood but also in every sphere of life. Women are forced to face the day-to-day challenges and restrictions in their lives, to ensure their ability for personal development and freedom, and gender equality, to live a healthier and dignified life, towards an inclusive and secure society. So, gender sensitization and widespread social change are needed to end crimes against women.

Dr. Anita Sable during her lecture enlightened the students about the laws, legislations which are already exist for the safeguard of women in Indian constitution and Indian government is amending it time to time, to prevent exploitation/ harassment of women and to address the

issues of discrimination and gender disparity. These include ‘The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009’, ‘The Criminal Law (Amendment) Act, 2013’, ‘The Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005’, ‘The Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961’, ‘The Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act, 1986’, ‘The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013’, ‘The Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006’, ‘The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976’, ‘The Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Act, 2017’ and the 73rd - 74th Amendment of the Constitution mandating 33% reservation for women in the local governance, And the Criminal Law (Amendment), Act 2013 has been enacted making the punishment more stringent for offences like rape, sexual assaults, etc.

Prof. Afroz Alam Head Dept of Political Science MANUU, in his presidential address, said that in India's social context, women are legally entitled to equal rights, but there is a great need to sensitize society on gender issues so that there is no problem. Women have the right to be free from violence, harassment, and discrimination. Removing the barriers of an unsafe environment can help women fulfil their potential as individuals and contributors to work, communities, and economies.

While interacting with students Prof. Shahida, Director Centre for Women’s Studies MANUU said the root cause of gender discrimination is the patriarchal mind prevalent in Indian society. Although this is now changing with urbanization and education, there is still a long way to go.

Ummar Farooque research scholar from DWE, convened the program and proposed vote of thanks. Scholars & students of Department of Women Education and from numerous departments participated in the Lecture.

Five research papers were presented in this session. The second paper was presented by research scholar Israr Ali, titled "Women's Empowerment through Sakhi One Stop Center Scheme: A Critical Analysis". The third paper was presented by research scholar Farheen Shama, titled "The Role of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme in Sustainable Development". Forth & Fifth papers were on the theme “Khawateen ki ba iqtiyari mein Technology ka role: Ek mualia” by Tanveer Ahmed Lone & “Paidar tarraquee ke liye Digital Shamuliyat ke zariye khawateen ko ba ikhtiyar banana : Sinf, Technology aur samaji iqtesadi pesh raft par ek case study” by Musrat Abdullah. Noorie Begum and Shaikh Ruqaiya Junaid performed the duties of convenors to conduct the session. Prof. Ameena Tahseen & Prof. Shahida delivered the presidential remarks and encouraged the paper presenters. The session concluded with a vote of thanks by Sana Firdous.
