The Chairman of the BOS welcomed all the members and commenced the proceedings after ascertaining the quorum for the meeting. Following agenda items have been discussed in the meeting.

AGENDA-1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 10th BOS (Emergent) approved through e-mail circulation on 28.03.2023.

RESOLUTION-1: The minutes of the 10th BOS approved through e-mail circulation on 28.03.2023 was unanimously confirmed (Annexure I). However, the BoS members were informed about the non-implementation of its **Resolution No. 1** due to the unanimous decision of the University's High Powered Committee on NEP-2020 Implementation of Four Years'

Under Graduate Programmes (FYUGP) to adopt Dual Major and in Multidisciplinary Mode for all UG Courses of the University.

AGENDA-2: To approve the minutes of 13th and 14th DRC meetings held on 01.03.2023 and 12.04.2023 respectively.

RESOLUTION-2: The minutes of 13th and 14th Departmental Research Committee (DRC) meetings held on 01.03.2023 and 12.04.2023 respectively were considered and approved (Annexure II).

AGENDA-3: To consider the Double Major and Multidisciplinary FYUG Programmes.

RESOLUTION-3: The BoS members were informed about the resolutions of the University's High Powered Committee on NEP-2020 Implementation of Four Years' Under Graduate Programmes (FYUGP) to adopt Dual Major and in Multidisciplinary Mode for all UG Courses of the University in a meeting held on 13 June, 2023 ((Annexure III). In view of the resolutions of the High Powered Committee, the BoS has resolved the followings:

- The resolution of the High Powered Committee to offer UG courses with Dual Major & in Multidisciplinary mode was considered and approved.
- The High Powered Committee's model template along with its credit structures to offer Dual Major and in Multidisciplinary Mode was considered and approved.
- It was resolved that the students opting for Political Science Major in FYUGP may be given the option to chose the Second Major from the courses offered by the School of Sciences, School of Commerce and Business Management, School of Arts & Social Sciences, School of Languages, Linguistics & Indology and the School of Mass Communication and Journalism.

AGENDA-4: To consider the course structure of the FYUG Programme.

RESOLUTION-4: After detailed discussion, the BoS has approved the course structure for the FYUG Programmes in Political Science Major along with its Course Titles and their Course Codes (Annexure IV).

AGENDA-5: To consider the Syllabus of the FYUG Programme

RESOLUTION-5: After detailed discussion, the BoS has approved the syllabuses of the following Discipline Specific Courses-Core (DSC), Discipline Specific Electives (DSE), Generic Electives (GE), Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) along with their credits and Semester allotment (Annexure V).
