



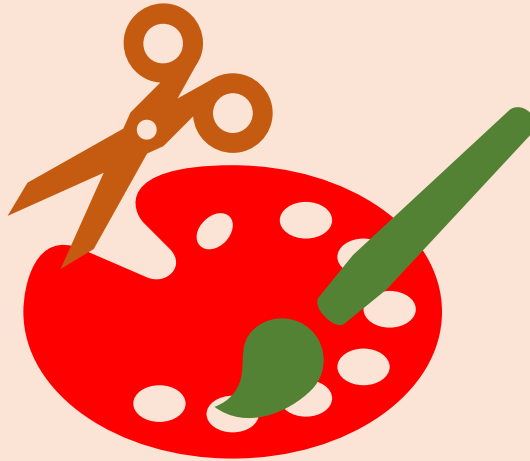

The College of Teacher Education, Bhopal, conducted a one-day workshop concerning the topic, 'Best out Of Waste' on 3/07/23.
