13.6 To seek ratification regarding enhancement to add Practical Fees of Rs. 750/- in the M.A. (JMC) programme from Academic Year 2023-2024 along with existing fee structure in the first year (First Semester) and Second year( Third Semester) Fee to meet the expenditure pertaining to transportation, Refreshment, consumable items like batteries and bulb etc, as approved by BOS.

13.7 To seek ratification regarding to conduct of 'Extension Lecture' on 15 September every year in the name of Moulvi Mohammad Baqar, Editor of 'Delhi Urdu Akhbar' who was the first Journalist considered as a martyr, as approved by BOS.

13.8 To seek ratification to name the 'Department Library' in the name of Moulvi Mohammad Baqar, as approved by BOS.

13.9 To seek ratification for outstation **'Educational Tour'** for a minimum duration 7 to 10 days for UG and PG student's of Final year and to enhance an amount of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) for PG Course and UG course also which will be charged along with 'Third Semester Fee' and 'V Semester Fee' respectively from the academic year 2023-2024, as approved by BOS.

It has been also recommended that some of the content pertaining to 'Social and Digital Media', shall be included in existing compulsory paper of 'Media Studies' offered in Ph.D (JMC) course work, as well as, added/updated in existing UG & PG programmes too offered by the Department.

13.4.6 The members of the School Board has approved to add 'Practical Fees' of **Rs. 750/-** in **M.A. (JMC) Programme** from Academic Year 2023-2024 along with existing fee structure in the First year (First Semester) and Rs. 750/- Second year (Third Semester) Fee to meet the expenditure pertaining to transportation, Refreshment, consumable items like batteries and bulb etc, subject to it's approval by the Academic Council of the University.

13.4.7 The members of the School Board has approved to organise the 'Extension Lecture' on 15 September of every year in the name of Moulvi Mohammad Baqar, Editor of 'Delhi Urdu Akhbar' who was the First Journalist considered as a Martyr, after it's due approval by Academic Council of the University.

13.4.8 The members of the School Board approved to name the **'Department Library'** in the name of **Moulvi Mohammad Baqar**, after it's ratification from the Academic Council of the University.

13.4.9 The members of the School Board has approved the outstation 'Educational Tour' for a minimum duration 7 to 10 days for UG and PG student's of the Final year and to collect Rs 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) towards the same, subject to it's ratification by the Academic Council of the University.
