Objectives of the campaign


Following are the objectives of the admission campaign:

Mode of Campaign:

Mode of admission campaign for the newly launched B.A. programme at CTE, Bhopal for the current academic session is given below:

1. Social Media: Admission campaign for B.A. programme carried out through different kinds of social networking platforms e.g. WhatsApp, Facebook, Twitter, Telegram and Instagram. Observations of Campaign Committee: Following are the observations of the Campaign Committee.

- ❖ It was a good experience as we could get familiar to the ground reality of the students of local community in terms of their educational aspirations and perceptions.
- Majority of the Government secondary schools do not offer Urdu subject to the students at 12 the standard.
- Students of CBSE School were found not to have Urdu subject at 12the standard.
- Majority of the local people were found not to aware even about the establishing and existence of MANUU-CTE, Bhopal.
- People of Abbas Nagar and Gandhi Nagar found with least interest in providing higher education to their children.
- Girls were found interested to pursue higher education but they don't have required support from their parents.
- Majority of the parents of Abbas Nagar and Ghandhi Nagar locality were found with financial problems.
- ❖ People of somewhat elite or well educated did not show interest in B.A Programme for their children.
- Parents attached with NGOs or Bait-ul-Maal were found interested in B.A programme.
- Some of the students showed interest in B.A programme but they also showed inability to attend the classes.
- Parents and students were found to have inclination towards the private education system where they could get degree without attending the classes.
- Some parents were found to be interested only in skill based programmes in place of B.A. programme.
- Some parents were found concerned with the transport facility from college to their destinations.

Suggestions of the Committee: Following are the suggestions of the committee.

- Last date of applying for the admission in B.A programme may be extended if possible.
- Need of rigorous door to door campaign in local community may be launched with the help of students.

- Community services in local community may be carried out by the CTE, Bhopal at regular interval.
- Educational awareness programme may be conducted in the name of community services.
- Weekly Evening classes/remedial teaching/coaching classes be may offered/conducted in the locality of Ghandhi Nagar and Abbas Nagar with the consent of interested faculty members of CTE, Bhopal.
- > Proper liaising need to be maintained with religious personalities, reputed members of the community, civil servants, Madarasas and NGOs.
- > Some need based skill programmes may be launched at CTE, Bhopal by keeping in mind the demography of the local community.
- > Provision of free education for girls and poor students may be made to attract the students from the poor family.
- Conveyance service may be provided from the certain points of the city if possible.
