Maulana Azad National Urdu University's Center for Women's Studies and Department of Women Education jointly organized an elocution competition for the students of university, titled "For ALL Women and Girls: Rights. Equality. Empowerment." The event, which aimed to provide a platform for students to express their views on women's empowerment, was held on 11th March 2025 and witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across various disciplines.

The competition was conducted in three languages - Urdu, Hindi, and English - and saw 41 registrations. Each participant was given five minutes to express their views on the theme. A panel of esteemed judges, comprising Dr. Abu Shameem Khan, Dr. Badar Sultana, Dr. Ashwani, Dr. Jahangir Alam, Dr. Abu Hurairah, Dr. Govindaiah

Godavarthi, Dr. Khairunnisa Nakathorige, and Dr. Qudsi Rizvi, evaluated the participants' performances, in their respective languages.

The winners of the competition were announced during a prize distribution ceremony on 12th March 2025, which was graced by renowned economist Professor Amirullah Khan as the chief guest and Registrar Professor Sk Ishtiaque Ahmed as the Guest of Honor. The winners included Mr. Abid Raza (Urdu), Mr. Muhammad Salman (Urdu), Alia Naz (Hindi), Aparajita Anand (Hindi), Ms. Mariya Suri (English), and Farheen Ghaffar Sanadi (English). Each winner received a cash prize of Rs. 1,500 and Rs. 1,000 for first and second place, respectively.

In his address, Professor Amirullah Khan emphasized the significance of women's empowerment in achieving national development. He noted that countries where women enjoy equal rights and opportunities are more likely to achieve sustainable development.

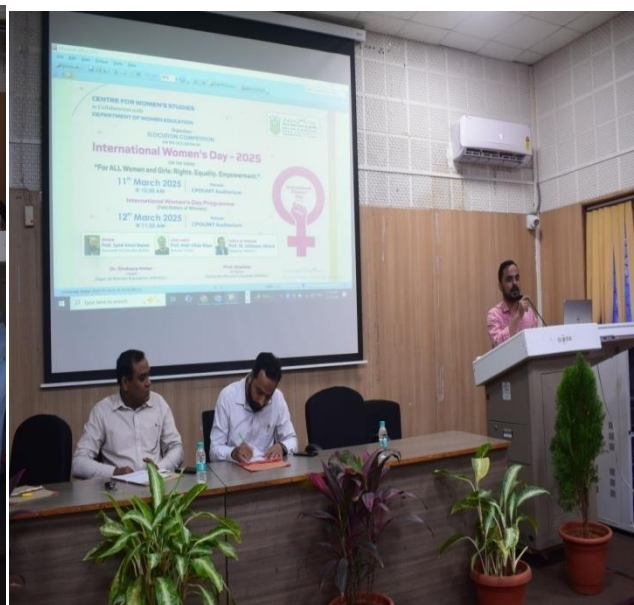
