<u>Report</u> on <u>Action Research Workshop</u>

MANUU College of Teacher Education, Aurangabad, conducted a highly beneficial Action Research Workshop for the B.Ed. students as part of their training for the school internship and teaching practice. The workshop aimed at equipping the teacher trainees with the knowledge, skills, and tools necessary for conducting action research in a classroom setting, which is an essential part of their teaching practice. The initiative was designed to foster a deeper understanding of teaching methods and help students reflect on their own teaching practices.

Objective of the Workshop: The primary objectives of the Action Research Workshop were:

- 1. To introduce B.Ed. students to the concept and methodology of action research.
- 2. To train them in identifying issues or challenges in the classroom that can be addressed through action research.
- 3. To help students develop skills to collect data, analyze it, and derive solutions to improve teaching and learning processes.
- 4. To enhance their understanding of reflective teaching practices.
- 5. To prepare them for their school internship and teaching practice by incorporating research methods into their teaching approach.

Workshop Highlights: The workshop was held over one day and was structured to provide a blend of theoretical knowledge and practical applications. The following activities and sessions were covered:

- 1. Orientation and Introduction (10:00 AM 11:00 AM): The workshop began with an introduction to action research by Dr. Shaheen Parveen (Assistant Professor), she explained its importance and relevance to teachers, particularly during their teaching practice. She discussed how action research enables teachers to reflect on their practices, identify challenges, and implement strategies to improve the learning outcomes of students.
- 2. Session-I (11:00 AM 1:00 PM): Technical session was taken by Dr. Rana Saeed (Assistant Professor, Cont.). In this session students were taken through the steps of

action research, which include identifying a problem, planning an intervention, collecting data, analyzing the data, and making informed decisions based on the findings. Emphasis was placed on the iterative nature of action research and how teachers can continuously adapt and refine their teaching methods. The workshop covered various research methods that could be used in the classroom context. This included qualitative and quantitative methods, data collection techniques like observations, surveys, interviews, and student assessments. Students were encouraged to select the method that best suited their research question and teaching context.

3. Session-II (Group wise work) (1:40 PM – 5:30 PM): A significant portion of the workshop was dedicated to hands-on practice. Participants were divided into groups under the supervision of staff including Dr. Badarul Islam, Mrs. Syeda Hajera Nausheen, Mrs. Siddiqui Uzma Tahseen, Mrs. Maisara Aziz Khan and Dr. Shaikh Yasmeen Mahamood, each tasked with identifying an issue in teaching or learning that could be addressed through action research. They were guided on how to formulate research questions, design a research plan, and begin collecting data. The final part of the workshop focused on analyzing the collected data and reflecting on the teaching process. Students learned how to interpret the results of their action research and make modifications to their teaching strategies. Reflective practices were emphasized as a critical tool for continuous improvement.

Key Takeaways for Students:

- Action Research in Practice: Students gained a comprehensive understanding of how action research can be practically applied in a teaching environment, helping them identify and solve classroom-related problems effectively.
- **Reflection:** Students were encouraged to adopt reflective practices as part of their regular teaching, improving their ability to make informed decisions based on data.
- **Collaboration:** Through group discussions and peer feedback, students learned the value of collaborative research, which enhances learning and the exchange of ideas.
- **Research Skills:** Students acquired foundational research skills, which are invaluable in both academic and professional teaching settings.

Conclusion: The Action Research Workshop organized by MANUU College of Teacher Education, Aurangabad, aimed at enhancing the teaching and research capabilities of B.Ed. students. It not only provided the necessary tools and techniques for conducting action research but also prepared students for their school internships by promoting reflective teaching practices. The workshop was a crucial step toward ensuring that the future teachers can engage in continuous professional development through action research, leading to improved classroom practices and better learning outcomes for students.

This workshop will undoubtedly have a lasting impact on the teaching practices of the participants and inspire them to approach teaching with a more analytical, data-driven mindset.
