Report of Anti-ragging Week

As per the directives of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and in alignment with the vision of creating a safe and inclusive campus, the CTE Bhopal observed Anti-Ragging Week from 12th to 18th August 2025 with great zeal and active participation from students and faculty. The specific objectives of the programme were to create awareness among students about the ill effects of ragging, to promote values of respect, cooperation and harmony in the campus and also to make students aware of the legal and institutional provisions against ragging. At the outset an orientation programme was conducted in which Prof. Noushad Husain Principal CTE addressed the students. He spoke about importance of maintaining a ragging-free environment he also highlighted, with the penalties and disciplinary actions associated with ragging. After that an introduction has been given by the anti-ragging committee members.



The next day an educational documentary on ragging and its psychological impact was screened for all students. The screening was followed by an open discussion, where students shared their views on fostering a safe and welcoming environment in the institution.

An open mic was also organized on the theme *Say No to Ragging* where students expressed their view on anti-ragging. After that a quiz competition was also held where questions focused on UGC guidelines, legal provisions, ethical aspects, and real-life case studies related to ragging. Students participated enthusiastically, showcasing their knowledge and awareness.

The students of CTE took the anti-ragging pledge. The students were guided by Dr. Shabbir Ahmed and Dr. Tarannum Khan for filling up the anti-ragging undertaking on the website www.antiragging.in as mandated by the University Grants Commission.

Upon filling up of the undertaking, the students generated their reference number and downloaded their undertaking affidavit. Thereafter, the students took the anti-ragging pledge which was administered by Dr.

The week concluded with a collective pledge by all students and staff to keep the campus ragging-free. Certificates were distributed to winners of the competitions, and faculty members appreciated the active involvement of students.



The Anti-Ragging Week proved to be highly impactful. Students gained awareness of the harmful effects of ragging, the legal implications, and the importance of maintaining a positive and respectful campus culture. The interactive activities ensured participation, engagement, and deeper understanding of the issue.
