Item No.51.1.00: Confirmation of the Minutes of 49th Academic Council meeting and 50th Emergent Academic Council meeting held on 07.01.2025 and 26.03.2025.

The Minutes of the 49th Academic Council meeting and 50th Emergent Academic Council meeting held on 07.01.2025 and 26.03.2025 were circulated among the members. Item No: 51.02.01: Programmes offered by the Department of Vocational Studies & Skill Development under School of Sciences.

The Academic Council ratified the recommendations of the Standing Committee of Academic Council for considering various programmes offered by the Department of Vocational Studies & Skill Development under School of Sciences (i.e) B.Voc. MLT (Medical Laboratory Technology), B.Voc. MIT (Medical Imaging Technology), B.Voc. ETT (Emergency & Trauma Care Technology) of four years duration with one year compulsory Internship as per NEP 2020. Two PG programs viz: M.Voc. MLT (Medical Laboratory Technology) and M.Voc. MIT (Medical Imaging Technology) and Ph.D. program in Allied Health Sciences (MLT) introduced from the academic session 2025-26.

Item No: 51.02.02: Introduction of Diploma in Calligraphy programme (one year).

The Academic Council ratified the recommendations of the Standing Committee of Academic Council for introduction of Diploma in Calligraphy one year programme (08 credits) consisting of two semesters only for women candidates by the Centre for Urdu Culture Studies at Urdu Hall, Himayathnagar, Hyderabad from the Academic year 2025-26. The Academic Council also considered to release the fresh admission notification for Diploma in Calligraphy from January 2026.

Item No: 51.02.03: Change in the Eligibility Criteria for admission to M.Sc. (Mathematics).

The Academic Council ratified the recommendations of the Standing Committee of Academic Council regarding change in eligibility criteria of Master of Sciences in Mathematics from 45% to 50% in aggregate B.A/ B.Sc. in Mathematics or B.A. / B.Sc. in Mathematics as one of the subjects in all three years from recognized University / Institution to avoid variation in percentage of eligibility when compared to other programmes offered by the School of Sciences.

Item No: 51.02.04: Change of Nomenclature of Department of Women Education to Department of Women Studies.


