### Items for Confirmation

#### 13.1 Confirmation of the Minutes of 12<sup>th</sup> School board meeting held on 21.11.2024

The Chairman briefed the minutes of 12<sup>th</sup> School Board Meeting of School of Technology which was held on 21.11.2024. The Minutes were-circulated among the board members. Since there were no comments received from any member, subsequently minutes of 12<sup>th</sup> School Board is considered as confirmed. (Annexure-II).

#### 13.2 Confirmation of Minutes of Board of Studies of Dept. of CS & IT

The School Board discussed the agenda items of 19<sup>th</sup> BoS Meeting of CS&IT Department held on 24.07.2025 and subsequently the same was approved. (Annexure III).

13.2.1 The External Board Members appreciated and approved the well-designed, revised Course Structure & Syllabus / LOCF of B.Tech, M.Tech & MCA Programmes of Dept. of CS & IT, which were approved in the 19<sup>th</sup> BoS meeting (Item No. 19.5) (Annexure IV).

13.2.2 Further the School Board Members appreciated and approved the Range of Credits offered in B.Tech(CS) programme in the revised LoCF. A typical Model Four-year Under Graduate degree program in Engineering has about 164 credits, the total number of credits proposed for the four-year B.Tech. in Computer Science (Engineering & Technology) is kept as 164 as per AICTE Norms. Additionally, the students of B. Tech (CS) who will earn an additional 20 credits through NPTEL/ SWAYAM/MOOCs or other UGC/AICTE/University approved online courses shall be awarded B.Tech. (Honors ) Degree.

### Items for Ratification:

13.3 The Board members discussed and approved the Fashion Technology & Interior Design programmes ( B.Sc, Diploma & Certificate) offered at MANUU Polytechnic Kadapa Campus and Diploma programme in Fashion Technology in Varanasi in collaboration with Arya Mahila P.G College as per the MoU between Samana College of Design Studies (SCDS) and MANUU under School of Technology with effect from the Academic Year 2025-2026.

### Items for Consideration

#### 13.4. Approval of Course Curriculum & Syllabus of B.Tech. (Civil Engg.)-Self finance mode

The External Board Members appreciated and approved the well-designed Course Structure & Syllabus / LOCF of B.Tech. (Civil Engg.) offered in Self Financing mode under School of Technology w.e.f. Academic year 2025-2026 as per the previous approval in 12<sup>th</sup> School Board Meeting and subsequently approved by Academic Council.

### 13.4.1 Awarding Honorary Degree in B.Tech (Civil Engg.)

Further the Board also recommended to follow the guidelines in line with B.Tech (CS) offered by Dept. of CS & IT i.e. to offer /award B.Tech. (Honors) Degree for the student who secures an **additional 20 credits** through NPTEL/ SWAYAM/MOOCs or other approved online courses apart from the total number of credits (i.e. 164) proposed for the four-year B.Tech in Civil Engg. (Self Finance) as per AICTE norms.

### 13.5 MANUU Polytechnics Agenda items

The proposal of Curriculum upgradation of all 8 branches of Polytechnics (i.e. Diploma in Civil Engg., ECE, CSE, IT, EEE, Mech. Engineering, Automobile & Apparel Technology) and incorporation of One Full-Semester Apprenticeship/ Industrial Training in the 6<sup>th</sup> Semester in all MANUU Polytechnics in line with AICTE Model Curriculum was recommended by the School Board and it was resolved to implement the same with certain modifications suggested by members w.e.f. the Academic Year 2026-2027.

### 13.6 Any other agenda items:

The external members, VC Nominees Prof. Mohammad Ubaidullah Bokhari, AMU has emphasized for the collaboration of Industrial projects.

Prof. Rafat Parveen, JMI has recommended to offer Apprenticeship / Internship for the ITI Students also.

Prof. D. K Lobiyal from JNU to offer more value-added courses in the programmes offered by School of Technology through electives.
