### Items for Confirmation

#### **13.1: Confirmation of the Minutes of 13<sup>th</sup> School board meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2025**

The Chairman briefed the minutes of 13<sup>th</sup> School Board Meeting of School of Technology which was held on 31.07.2025. The Minutes were circulated among the board members. Since there were no comments received from any member, subsequently minutes of 13<sup>th</sup> School Board is considered as confirmed. (Annexure-II).

#### **13.2: Confirmation of Minutes of Board of Studies (BoS) of Dept. of CS & IT**

The School Board discussed the agenda items of 20<sup>th</sup> BoS meeting of Department of CS&IT held on 02.03.2026 and subsequently approved by School Board members. (Annexure III).

#### **13.3: Confirmation of Minutes of DRCs of Dept. of CS & IT**

The School Board discussed the agenda items of 18<sup>th</sup> DRC Meeting held on 06.08.2025 and 19<sup>th</sup> DRC Meeting held on 06.02.2026. The same was approved by board members. (Annexure IV & V).

#### **13.4: Conversion of Full-Time Ph.D. Program into Ph.D. Part-Time (Extra-Mural)**

The recommendation BoS Committee for the conversion of Full-Time Ph.D. Program of Research Scholar, Mr. Md. Shamshad (Enrollment No. A220647) into Ph.D. Part-Time (Extra-Mural) was approved by the School Board.

### Items for Consideration

#### **13.5: Guidelines to offer B.Tech. Honors Degree program in Engineering**

The 51<sup>st</sup> Academic Council of MANUU approved the revised course curriculum of B.Tech. Honours in Computer Science of 164 credits with additional 20 more credits (for Honours Degree) from MOOCs, Swayam, NPTEL etc. w.e.f. the Academic Year 2025-26 in Department of CS&IT. In this regards the guidelines and modality to offer the 20 credits for Honours degree from MOOCs, Swayam, NPTEL etc. were discussed thoroughly by board members and approved as attached in Annexure VI.

#### **13.6: Approval of revised version of course codes**

The Board Members discussed and approved the revised version of Course Codes (for B.Tech, M.Tech and MCA) as forwarded and formulated by 20<sup>th</sup> BoS meeting for revised curriculum structure of B. Tech, M.Tech & MCA which was approved in 51<sup>st</sup> AC (Annexure VII).

#### **13.7: Introduction of Certificate Program in Jewelry Design**

51<sup>st</sup> Academic council (Agenda Item No.51.04.02) approved to introduce Certificate program in Jewelry Design and directed the School Board of Technology to formulate course curriculum, in this regards a Six-months Certificate Program in Jewelry Design as specialization of Fashion Technology program under the School of Technology, in collaboration with Samana College of Design Studies (SCDS) was recommended by the Board. The board members also resolved that the certificate program may also be offered twice in an academic year. The Chairman of Samana College of Design Studies (SCDS) has submitted the course structure & syllabus to the School Board of School of Technology duly designed and formulated by experts of concerned field. The same was approved by the Board members to start the program at Hyderabad Campus. (Annexure VIII).



**13.8: Introduction of Certificate program in Fashion Technology and Diploma Programs in Fashion Technology and Interior Design**

The board members thoroughly discussed and approved the introduction and curriculum structure of the following program at **Hyderabad, Kadapa and Varanasi** campuses for 10<sup>th</sup> passed out candidates under the MoU of SCDS. The Chairperson of Samana College of Design Studies (SCDS) has submitted the course structure & syllabus to the School Board duly designed and formulated by experts of concerned field. (Annexure IX,X,XI) The board members also resolved that the Certificate and Diploma programs may also be offered twice in an academic year.


- I. One year Diploma in Fashion Technology
- II. One year Diploma in Interior Design
- III. Six months Certificate in Fashion Technology

**13.9: To Start 100 Days Crash Course in Fashion Technology by SCDS**

The proposal to start a 100 Days Crash Course in Fashion Technology by Samana College of Design Studies (SCDS) at Urdu Hall, Hyderabad (only for Women) was approved by the School Board. The course structure & syllabus was submitted to the School Board of School of Technology by the Chairperson SCDS and vetted by concerned experts. (Annexure XII)
