

Minutes of the DRC Meeting held on 24th March 2026 at 5:00 PM

DRC Meeting of the Al Beruni Centre for the Study of Social Inclusion was held at 5.00 PM on 24th March, 2026 and after discussing the Agenda items, the following resolutions were made:

1.	Confirmation of previous DRC Meeting Minutes held on 10.09.2025	Accepted.
2	Approval of First RAC Minutes held on 19.09.2025and Second RAC held on 22.01.2026 and 17.02.2026, of all PhD scholars of the Centre	Accepted.
3	Cancellation of the registration of PhD scholars, Mr.Salman Shah TN (Enrolments No:24PHSE1002HY) and Mr.Jafar Shameem K (Enrolments No: 24PHSE1004HY) as they are not in touch with the supervisor/centre over the last two semesters	<p>Both research scholars (Mr. Salman Shah TN and Mr. Jafar Shameem K) have consistently failed to report to the Centre and were absent from two consecutive Research Advisory Committee (RAC) meetings held on 19.09.2025 and 22.01.2026. The matter was duly placed before the DRC, which, after careful consideration, accepted the report and recommended the cancellation of their PhD registrations, noting that all prescribed procedures were properly followed in arriving at this decision.</p> <p>MANUU PHD Regulations: As per the Clauses: 19.1 to 19.2 and 22.2 to 22.4 of "The Regulations for the PhD Program of MANUU, 2023", "if any research scholar fails to appear before RAC for two consecutive terms or fails to show two half-yearly progress reports of his/her research, their registration is liable to be cancelled." Therefore, the DRC members recommended the cancellation of the registration of both these PhD students in accordance with University Guidelines, as they both failed to attend two consecutive RAC meetings or/and have not shown two half yearly progress reports of their research.</p>

Dr. Ishtiyque Ahmad (Associate Professor, CDOE) 5. Dr. Malik Raihan Ahmed (Assistant Professor, CDOE) <p>The DRC approved the proposal to formally authorize these faculty members to supervise PhD scholars admitted to CSSI, MANUU. It also approved the admission of 10 candidates to the PhD programme for the Academic Year 2026-27.</p>
