Other Events

- 1. In line with the tradition of previous years, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Lucknow Campus organized various inter University/College competitions, namely, Poster making, Baitbaazi, Quiz, Reading Azad etc., to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Education Minister of Independent India.
