The detail report of the dissertation is submitted separately, during the presentation, presenters suggested the following points for future researches:

- those areas which are left uncovered so far should be taken for further research.
- those topics which are not taken in Bhopal but undertaken in other CTE's should be avoided.
- ugc -stride guidelines should be followed for topic selection.
- as suggested in previous presentation emphasis should be on transdisciplinary, multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary topics.
- topics selection should be done by students, it should not be imposed on them, rather students should be sensitized so that they choose the topic on their own.
- more emphasis to be given on qualitative research, mixed method research and case studies.
- focus group discussions, observations and interviews should be used along with standardized tools for data collection.
- topics discussed in previous orientation should be emphasized for further research
- at least one self-developed tool should be used during M.Ed dissertation, so that the students learn the steps involved in tool development.

The presentation was followed by fruitful discussion among the staff members under the able guidance of Prof.Noushad Husain, Principal, CTE-MANUU Bhopal. The presentation was appreciated by Principal Sir and all faculty members.
