## Interactive Session on *Atmnirbhar Bharat*

To make acquaint to the prospective teachers for *Atmnirbhar Bharat* a panel of discussion was organized on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of May, 2023. Dr Shabana Ashraf opened the program by welcoming the students and the speakers alike; followed by a brief introduction on the topic of discussion for the day. **Atmanirbhar Bharat** or **Abhiyaan** or **Self-reliant India** campaign is the vision of new India envisaged by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. He raised a clarion call to the nation giving a kick start to the Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan (Self-reliant India campaign) and announced the Special economic and comprehensive package of INR 20 lakh crores - equivalent to 10% of India's GDP – to fight COVID-19 pandemic in India.



She then called Dr Bhanu Pratap Pritam on-stage to discuss the concept of *Atmanirbhar* Bharat in detail. He enlightened the audience with his thoughtful and elaborate ideas surrounding the idea. He stated that the mission's aims towards cutting down import dependence by focussing on substitution while improving safety compliance and quality goods to gain global market share. The Self-Reliance signifies neither any exclusionary or isolationist strategies but involves creation of a helping hand to the whole world. Rather the Mission focuses on the importance of promoting "local" products.
