Theme of the seminar

Maulana Abul Kalam Azad: A Visionary Educationist and a Revolutionary Leader

Maulana Abul Kalam Azad was a towering figure in the twentieth century and his celebration of birth day on 11 November as National Education Day will go a long way in understanding his profound educational ideas and philosophy. As a distinguished scholar, great statesman, Maulana Azad was imbued with lofty ideals of nationalism, pluralism, democracy, and rationalism. His

contribution to the field of Indian education is not only massive but also remarkable milestones when viewed in historical perspective. Being a dynamic and visionary educationist, he realised the importance of education not only in terms of eradicating poverty, illiteracy and gender bias from the Indian scene but also wanted to use education as an effective tool for social change and rapid economic growth of the country. Virtually, he played a significant role in reshaping, restructuring and reorganising the education system of the country. He is also regarded as one of the Post-Independence architect of modern Indian Education System. From the study of Azad's ideas on the educational policies, one is able to comprehend the four important objectives that he promoted as the new goals of education, were Democratisation of education, Maintenance of educational standards, Broadening of educational outlook and Promotion of mutual understanding. The Union Education Ministry, under his command, for the first time in its history adopted thoughtful and visionary ideas and translated those into reality. Thus the golden era in the realm of education was from 1947 to 1958. During this period different Committees and Commissions were constituted to improve the system of education. As such, the University Commission (1948), All India Council for Secondary Education, Secondary Education Commission (1952), All India Council for Technical Education, Adult Education, Rural Higher Education, Central Social Development Board, Central Education Board, Educational and Vocational Guidance Bureau, National Organisation for Basic Education, Council for Scientific and Technical Research were established during his period. Besides, three academies were also established (1) Sahitya Academi, (2) Art Academi and (3) Dance-Drama and Music Academi. A new Department was opened in the Education Ministry for establishing cultural relations with UNESCO and international cultural organisations. A new organisation was also created for strengthening education through exchange of views between teachers and the taught. All these steps taken by him offer ample testimony to the fact that he was an ardent votary of the theory of united nationalism and pluralism.

He also drew up several programmes for development of Hindi and its acceptance as the national language. He launched several schemes for physical education, excursions, betterment of youngsters, social service, education for disabled persons, etc. It is indisputable that the educational developmental plans were started during Maulana Azad's stewardship. He realised the fact that the country could achieve a higher level of progress and advancement only by making the education system of the country more practical, pragmatic and, above all, by meeting the immediate demands of society and the industry as a whole.

The seminar on his educational ideas and vision for the country would be true homage to him. In this context, a seminar on the theme of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad : A Visionary Educationist and Revolutionary Leader is relevant. This seminar would help to disseminate his vision and philosophical ideas to large community of students, teachers and scholars.
