5 -Day Online Workshop on E-Learning for Teachers

BACKGROUND

The Centre for Professional Development of Urdu Medium Teachers (CPDUMT) at MANUU is a training centre which organizes pedagogical programs and caters to the needs of Urdu Medium Teachers having varying specializations. Since 2007, the Centre has conducted 81 such programs, witnessing more than 10,000 participants. During the pandemic, the Centre has organized about 15 online programs, including those in collaboration with organizations like NCPUL-New Delhi, Telangana Urdu Academy-Hyderabad, and other departments of MANUU.

With the advent of technology, a wide range of electronic resources are being utilized for effective teaching and learning. The recent pandemic has made it clear that online mode of teaching and learning is here to stay. Educators teaching at different levels have used the available e-platforms to keep the learning process going on. There is a need to inform them about the various teacher friendly tools and resources. In addition to the concepts, the skill to utilize them is also a domain to be focussed on.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the workshop are to

- 1. Explain the concepts and significance of E-learning.
- 2. Explore the tools and resources required for online education.
- 3. Focus on the skills needed for effective use of digital tools and resources.

APPROACH

The workshop will be based on an online session everyday with each session spanning 90 minutes. On completion of the workshop, e-certificates will be provided to the participants.

PARTICIPIANTS

Participants will include school and college teachers (10+2) with Urdu as the medium of instruction. Additional participants will include madarsa teachers.
