While a few heritage monuments and sites located in the Deccan region have already received the prestigious UNESCO World Heritage recognition and there are many more monuments and sites which have the potential for inscription on the UNESCO World Heritage List. As Telangana is yet to get its first site inscribed on that list, organizing this Workshopcum-Meet is a key step in capacity building for cultural resources management in this young state. The H. K.
