

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Tafsir refers to the field of study which deals with the human interpretations and understanding of the verses of Holy Quran, in accordance with the linguistic properties of the text and Shari'a sciences. The use of this most exalted and dominant field of study is innumerable; which include a) extracting Shari'a rules from Quran, b) understanding the moral meanings of the stories narrated in Quran, c) internalising the best characters and traits etc. The instructional activities in Quranic sciences, specifically in Indian subcontinent, date back to the advent of Islam to the place. In the first phase, works of scholars were limited to adding annotations and footnotes to the existing commentaries. 7th Century Hijra onwards, scholars started writing independent Tafsir texts. In the periods of Gaznavids, Mamluks, Mogals and colonialists, a lot of energy has gone into the field. It resulted in a great revolution of production of several Tafsirs in Arabic language as well as the local languages such as Urdu, Persian, Tamil, and Malayalam etc. However, most of such works lay neglected on the dusty shelves of libraries. There is a high demand of turning the academic attention to these works and bringing them to light. While some of the Tafsirs have already been printed and are widely used for the academic purposes, there are many other works which have not been given proper attention. To bring out the value of these Indian versions of Tafsirs by doing research on them, we in invite academicians and researchers to participate in this seminar with their academic contributions.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SEMINAR

- To bring out the role of Indian scholars in the field of research in Tafsirs al Quran.
- To study traditional and modern Tafsirs from Indian subcontinent, with a special reference to the Arabic literature.
- To undertake an academic review of Arabic and non-Arabic Tafsirs.
- To provide an opportunity for researchers to study the Indian contributions to the field of Tafsir.
- Exchange of scientific, literary and intellectual outputs between scholars and experts in the field of Tafsir.

GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION

- The abstract of the research paper can be sent in Arabic, Urdu or English; in not more than 400 words, with its key words.
- Attach a brief note about the author; which should include full name, academic qualification, affiliations, Whats App number, and e-mail.
- The research paper should be original and should not be published anywhere or presented in any seminar.
- The article should be between 3000-5000 words; It should be formatted with page size: A4.
- For Arabic submissions, use 'Traditional Arabic' font; font size: 16; line spacing: 1.5 lines; and footnote font size: 12.
- For Urdu submissions, use 'Jameel Noori Nastaleeq' font; font size 15; line spacing: 1.5 lines; and footnotes font size: 12.
- For English submissions, use 'Times New Roman' font; font size: 12; line spacing: 1.5 lines; and footnotes font size: 10.
- Write footnotes and references at the end of each page, and to key the list of references at the end of the paper, sorted alphabetically, as per Modern Language Association (MLA) manual; as follows: author's last name, author's full name, title of the book, edition, city of publication: publisher, year of publication.
- The paper should be free from linguistic, grammatical, morphological and spelling errors.
- The authors of the abstract will be notified via email, once the review panel has accepted the proposal.
- The seminar is open to all academicians, postgraduate students, researchers, and those who are interested in the field Quran and related sciences.
- ❖ All papers will be reviewed.
- The seminar will be conducted only in offline mode.
- Research papers sent after the deadline will not be considered. The papers will be published in the form of a book after the seminar.
- Due to the fund constraints, participants will not be given the travel allowance. However, the organizers will host the delegates during the time of seminar.
