Full paper shall be submitted by 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024, not exceeding 4000 to 6000 words typed in double space A4 size, Times New Roman, font size 12 for text, 13 for sub heading and 14 for main heading. Referencing pattern should be in APA (7<sup>th</sup> Edition) format with in text citations.
